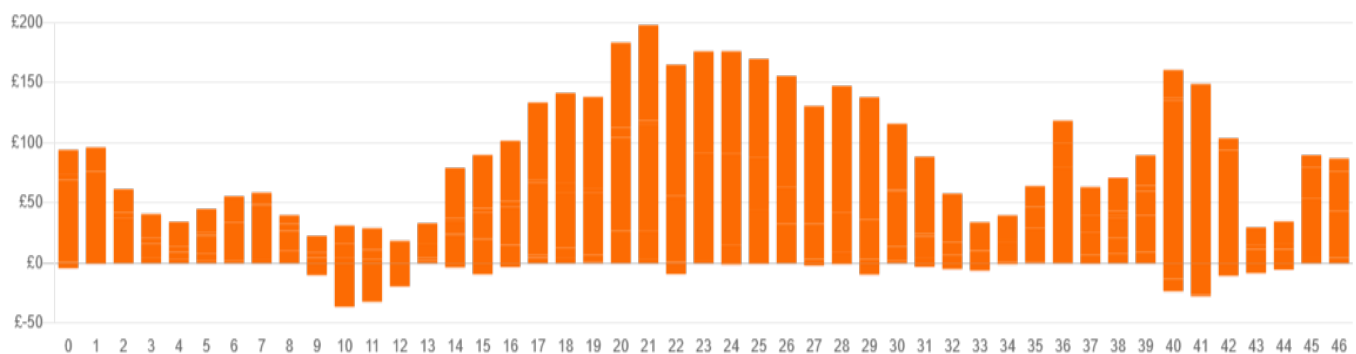

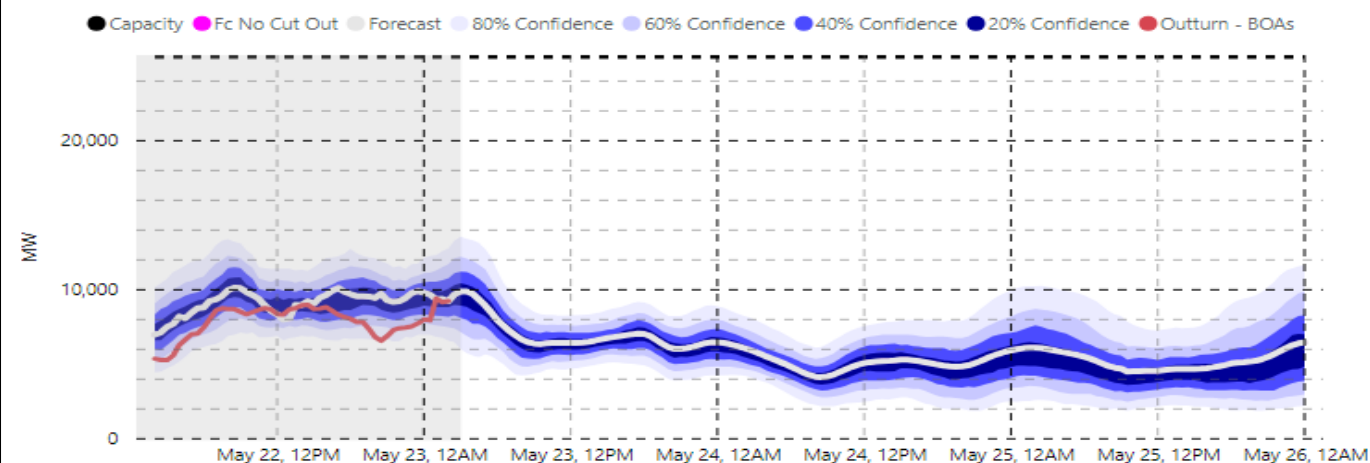

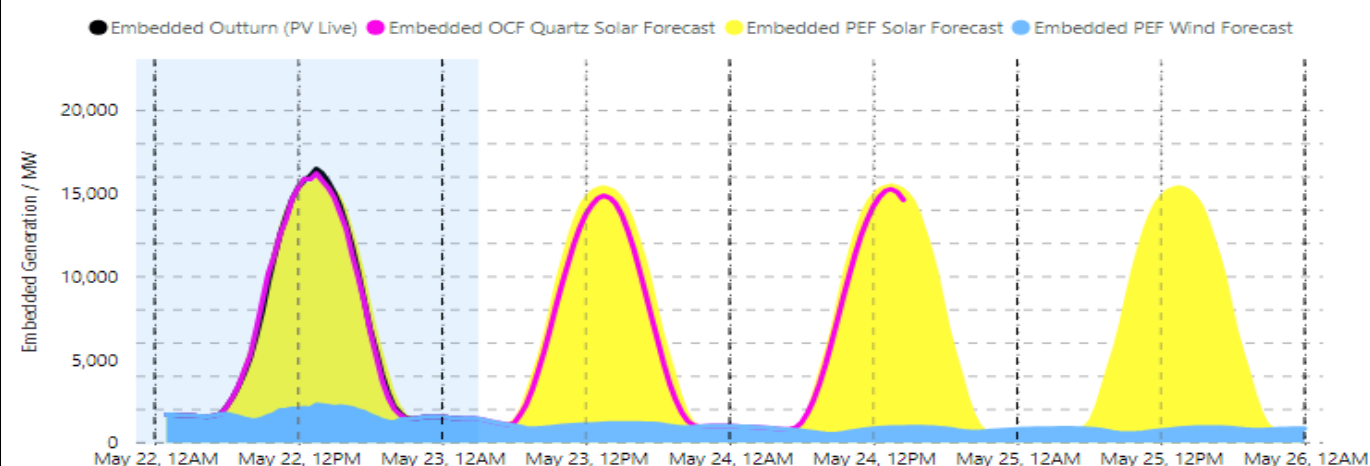
Wind Power Forecast
