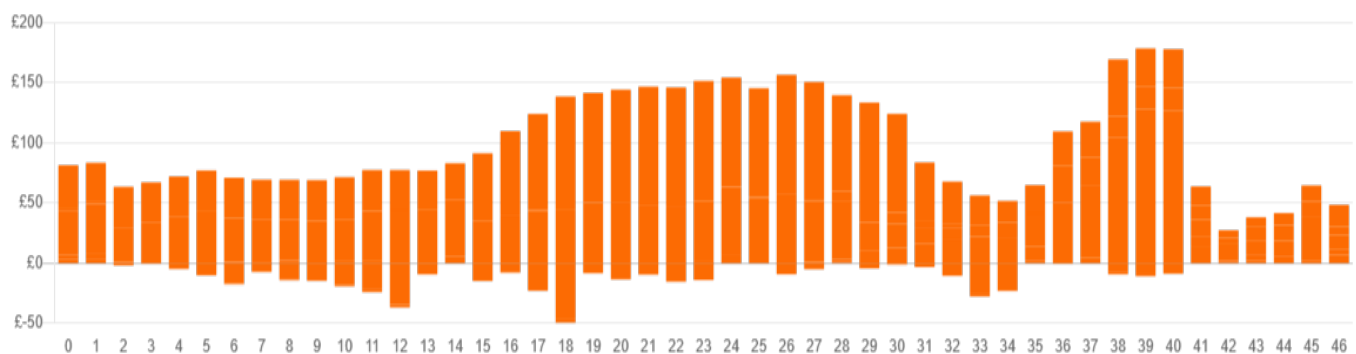

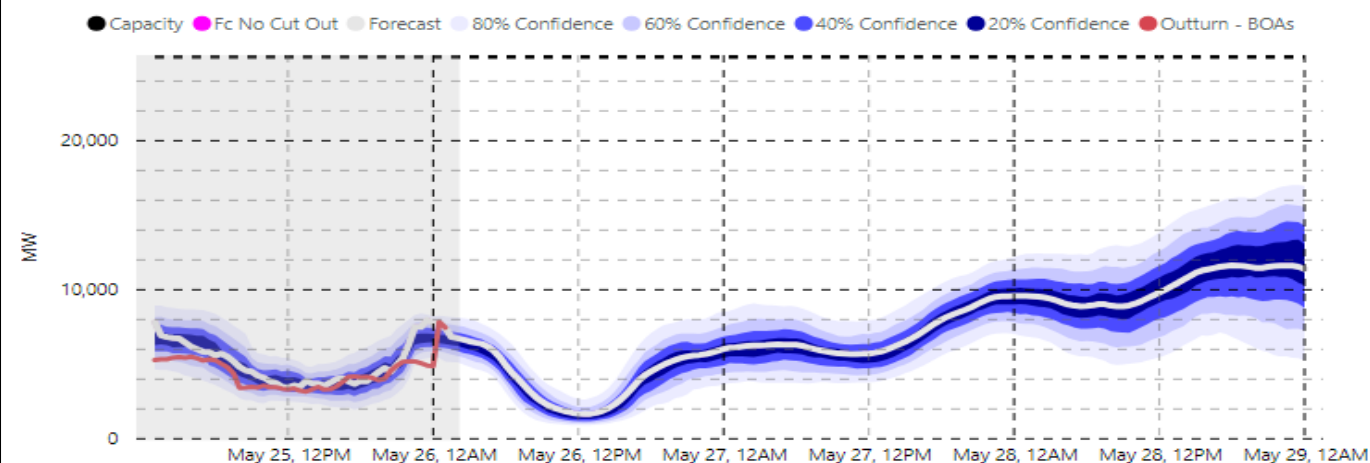

Wind Power Forecast

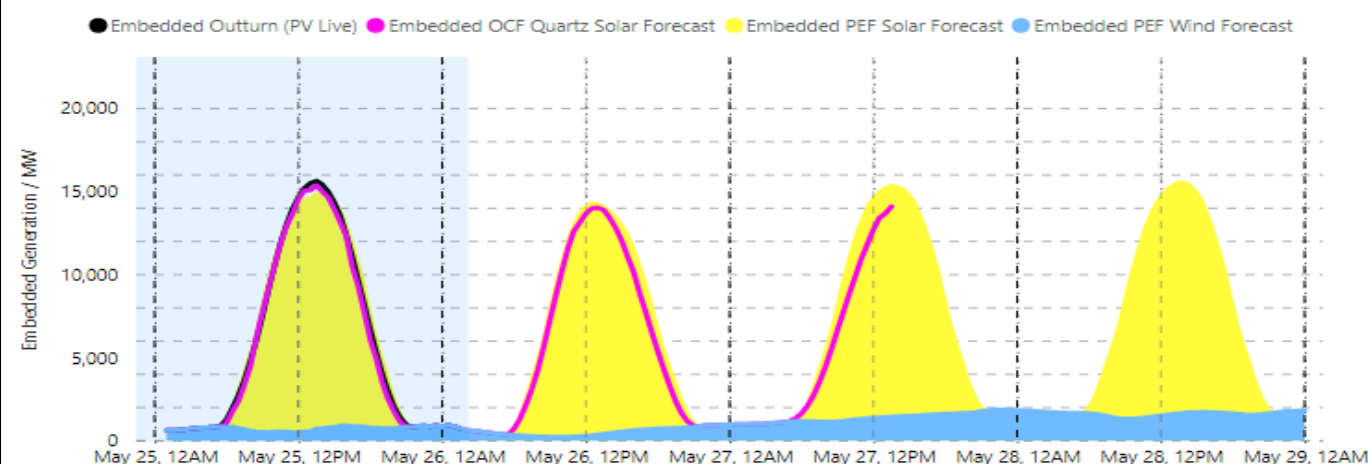


Expected embedded generation (MWs)
