

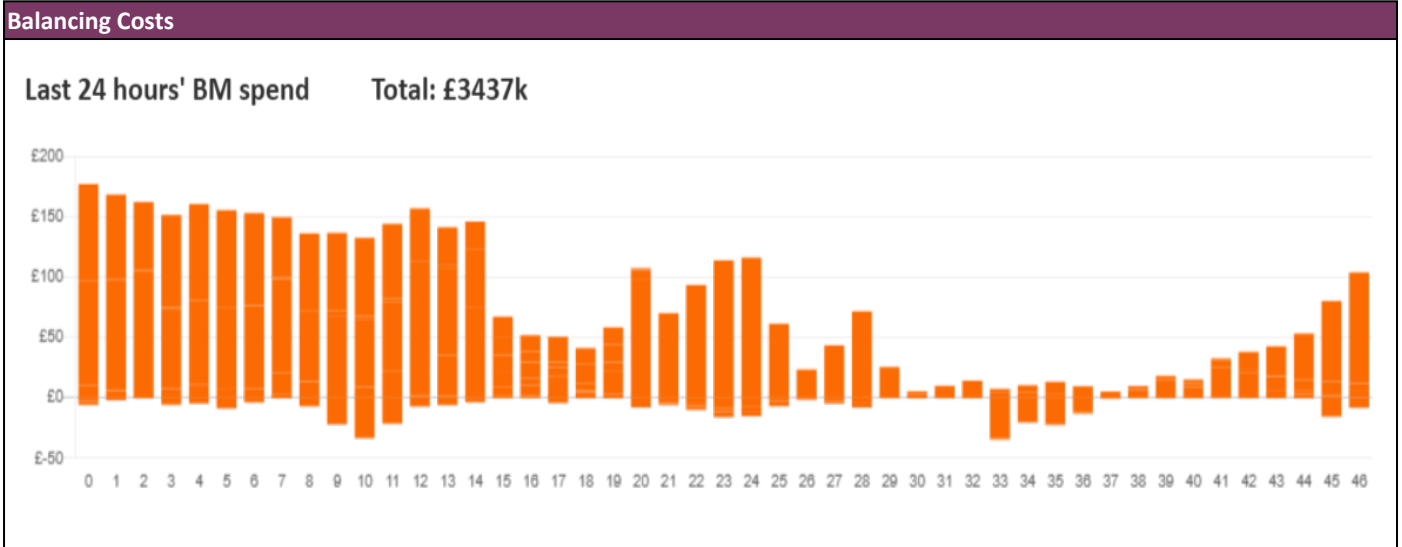

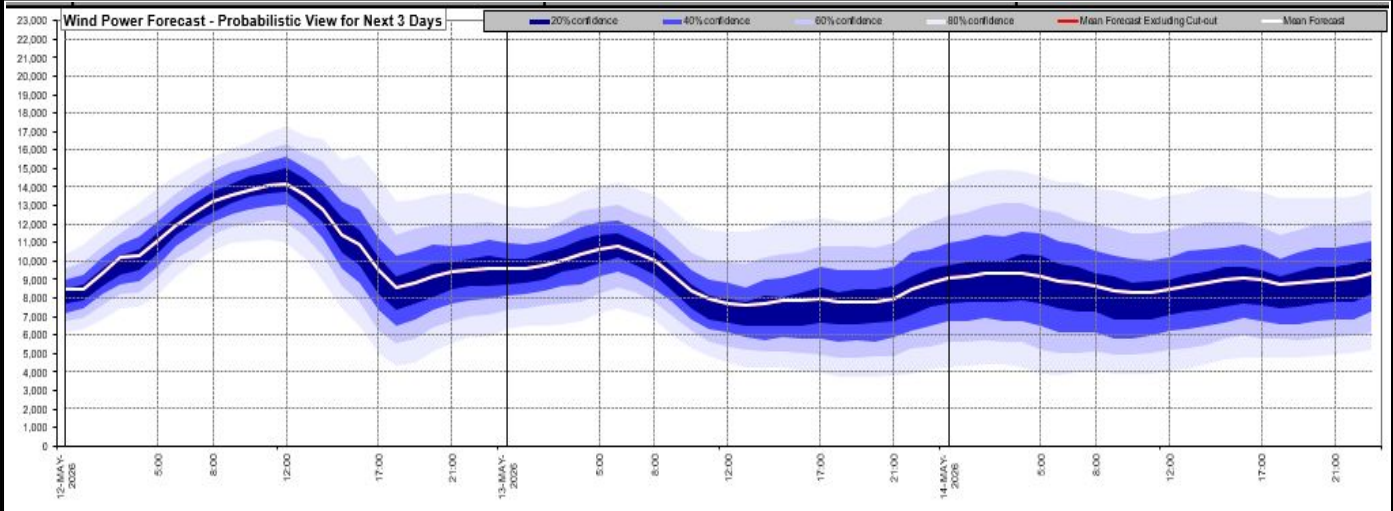

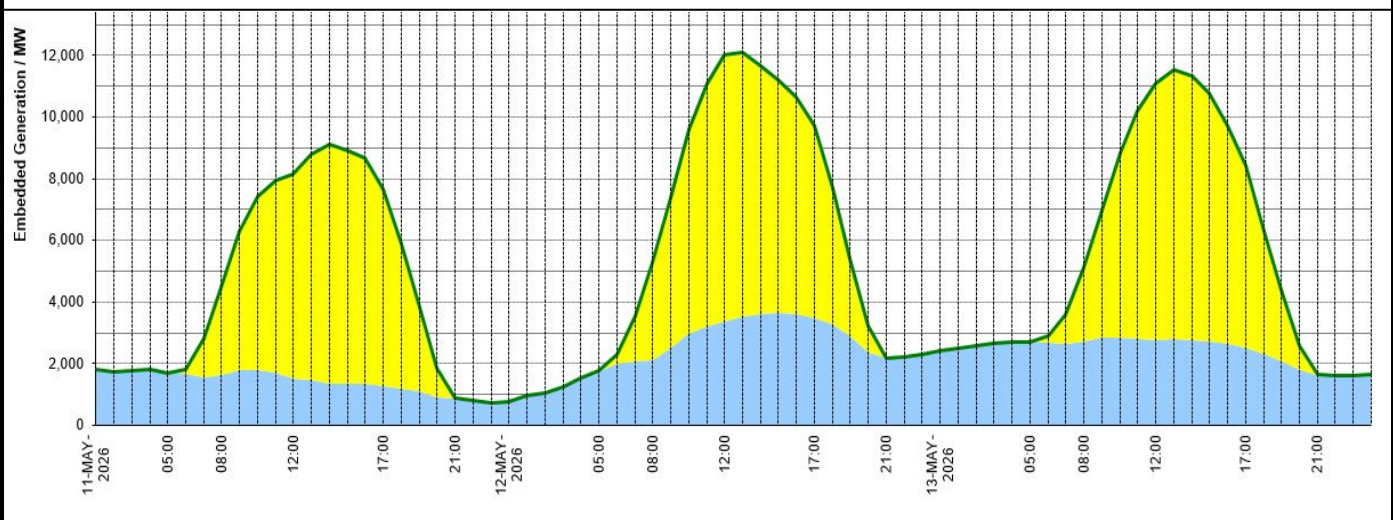
Wind Power Forecast

A band of cloud and increasingly patchy rain moving southeastwards across England and Wales. Sunnier skies to the northwest, but with showers, some heavy. Cool, with blustery winds in the northwest.</p> <p>Tonight: Patchy rain clearing from southeast England, then chilly with clear periods in the south this evening. However, blustery showers in the northwest becoming increasingly widespread overnight, some heavy and thundery.</p>
