

Good afternoon

I am a Parish Councillor and resident of a Parish in Norfolk which faces on-going issues from onshore cabling. I was not aware of this consultation process and am extremely disappointed that there is not the opportunity for the Parish Council to feedback.

My personal views are that any offshore solution must be made with complete understanding of the impacts for onshore. In other words, consideration should be given to an Offshore Rings Main which comes in once and eliminates the need to continually dig and disrupt the life of residents and the environment. It will also eliminate the need for large sub stations to keep springing up in various locations, again with the disturbance that brings.

I also ask for all current projects to be put on hold pending the outcome of your investigation. Delaying current projects will have no impact in meeting government targets for net zero carbon transmission.

Please can you ensure that Barford and Wrampingham Parish Council are included in future dialogues.
