- That compliance with the use of system charging methodology facilitates effective competition in the generation and supply of electricity and (so far as is consistent therewith) facilitates competition in the sale, distribution and purchase of electricity;*
- That compliance with the use of system charging methodology results in charges which reflect, as far as is reasonably practicable, the costs (excluding any payments between transmission licensees which are made under and accordance with the STC) incurred by transmission licensees in their transmission businesses and which are compatible with standard licence condition C26 requirements of a connect and manage connection);*

2	Do you support the proposed implementation approach?	We are supportive of the proposed implementation approach and wish to draw attention to the implementation plans for other BSUoS Reform CUSC modifications (CMP361 & CMP362). Due to the possibility of different approval dates, and therefore different CUSC baseline text being used, there is a chance a further modification will be required to ensure that the legal text works as intended across the three existing BSUoS reform modifications. Additionally, we would like to highlight that due to the urgent BSUoS mod CMP373, the legal text baseline currently being used for CMP308 may not be correct and may need to be updated before submission to Ofgem. This is not expected to impact the legal text changes.
3	Do you have any other comments?	For the avoidance of doubt, we'd like to clarify that the implementation approach for CMP308 is significantly different to the approach previously planned for CMP201. Amending the BSUoS charging base to include Final Demand only requires data and processes from a range of internal and external sources creating a more complex implementation approach. The ESO aims to implement CMP308 on a new ESO billing system to unlock process efficiencies.
