### WACM3

The legal text for WACM3 is the same as the legal text for the original CMP376 apart from the changes shown in **red and strikethrough** below to Paragraph 16.3 (The User Progression Milestones and Evidence) of the new CUSC Section 16 specifically:

- (i) to the first sub - paragraph after the first table within that Paragraph:

The date by which a **User Progression Milestone** has to be achieved is derived from the following Tables working (i) **other than in the case of Milestone M3 (Land Rights)**, backwards from the **Completion Date** (or where staged, relevant **Completion Date**) in a **Connection Offer** to the date on which the **Connection Offer** is made by **The Company** to the **User** and (ii) **in the case of Milestone M3 (Land Rights) working forward from the date of the Construction Agreement entered into between The Company and the User in acceptance of the Offer.**

- (ii) to the second table (Conditional Progression Milestones) within that Paragraph:
