Dear Nadir

This is the CUSC Panel's Self-governance Statement to the Authority for CUSC Modification Proposal CMP429: Typographical and formatting updates following the implementation of CMP376 (Inclusion of Queue Management process within the CUSC). National Grid ESO has prepared this Self-Governance Statement on behalf of the CUSC Panel and submits it to you in accordance with the CUSC.

On 26 January 2024, the CUSC Panel considered **CMP429** and confirmed unanimously that it meets the Self-governance criteria and the Fast Track Criteria.

As such, CMP429 is unlikely to discriminate between different classes of CUSC Parties and is unlikely to have a material effect on:

- i) Existing or future electricity customers;
- ii) Competition in the generation, distribution, or supply of electricity or any commercial activities connected with the generation, distribution or supply of electricity,
- iii) The operation of the National Electricity Transmission System
- iv) Matters relating to sustainable development, safety or security of supply, or the management of market or network emergencies
- v) The CUSC's governance procedures or the CUSC's modification procedures
