

Continuous Improvement

Q3 (FY2026) Customer Enhancements Development & Delivery – Identified and prioritised customer enhancements. These are;

Notify DSR Components – We have refined the ‘Notify DSR Components’ process through which a Capacity Provider uploads components for an Unproven Demand Side Response (DSR) Capacity Market Unit (CMU). Improvements include upgraded system capabilities to accommodate larger volumes of DSR Components, functionality to monitor successes and failures, as well as expanded filtering options for more effective management of DSR components.

Q4 (FY2026) Customer Enhancements Development & Delivery – Identified and prioritised customer enhancements. These are;

Application Validation: This feature adds a sidebar for users to view validation errors and warnings related to New Build Interconnector, Existing Interconnector, Refurbishing Generating, and Refurbishing Interconnector CMU types. Warnings appear for incomplete or conditionally validated fields, while errors like incorrect capacity formatting are shown during Save and Submit. This will be available for the 2026 Prequalification Submission Window.

Company Transfer Process – CM portal automation of the process of transferring a company from one portfolio to another or a company from a portfolio to be independent or a company that is independent into an existing portfolio.

Filter Retention functionality – The retention of filter settings and positions, even when the user navigates away from the current page or section and later returns. This functionality ensures an improved experience by reducing the need for users to reapply filters each time they revisit a page.

Knowledge Site UI improvements – We’ve made minor updates, including clearer site names and renaming the ‘published industry announcements’ tile to ‘Stress Event’. From now on, Delivery Body Updates & Events will be posted on the EMR website. These changes aim to simplify resource access and enhance customer service.

Rule & Regulatory Changes

NESO – Capacity Market: Consultation on updating the Relevant Balancing Services Guidelines [completed] – EMR Delivery Body published a consultation seeking views on updating the Relevant Balancing Services (RBS) Guidelines for the Capacity Market. These updates seek to add Slow Reserve to the list as well as removing Enhanced Frequency Response and updating Firm Frequency Response to Static Firm Frequency Response. This consultation concluded on the 14 October and the Delivery Body have published their Report to the Authority, alongside the SPEN consultation response, and the draft version of updated Guidelines. DESNZ Capacity Market: proposed changes for Prequalification 2026 [completed] – The Department for Energy Security and Net Zero has published a consultation seeking views on changes to the Capacity Market that aim to ensure continued security of supply, align the scheme with the government’s decarbonisation goals, and improve the functionality of the scheme. The consultation will be open for 8 weeks, closing on 27 November at 11.59pm; it can be found on GOV.UK.

DESNZ have decided not to proceed with implementing the policy proposals associated with the Multiple Price Capacity Market (MPCM) ahead of prequalification for the next Capacity Market Auction in March 2027.

Policy decisions on the other matters consulted on will be set out in full in a consultation response in spring 2026.

DESNZ – CM: proposal regarding locational changes of Capacity Market Units [completed]– The consultation proposes urgent changes to the Rules to remove the provisions which allow any New Build Capacity Market Units (CMUs) or Demand Side Response (DSR) CMU to change the location of a Generating Unit or DSR CMU Component after Prequalification. This consultation ran from 10am on 3 November 2025 to 11:59pm on 28 November 2025. The government intends to implement changes in advance of the March 2027 auctions.

DESNZ – CM: proposals to integrate low carbon technologies and enhance delivery assurance ahead of Prequalification 2026 [completed]– The Department for Energy Security and Net Zero has published a consultation seeking views on;

1. Managing the transition of Existing Generating Capacity Market Units (CMUs) into alternative schemes
2. Long Duration Electricity Storage Cap and Floor (LDES C&F)
3. Improving Delivery Assurance
4. Clarifying Rules around Secondary Trading entrants and CMU transferors
5. Introducing additional measures to support eligibility for the Multiple Price Capacity Market. *Update position – decision not to proceed with implementing the policy proposals associated with the Multiple Price Capacity Market (MPCM) ahead of prequalification for the next Capacity Market Auction in March 2027.*

This consultation ran from 11:30am on 2 December 2025 to 11:59pm on 8 January 2026.

Policy decisions on the other matters consulted on will be set out in full in a consultation response in spring 2026.

Ofgem – Capacity Market Rule change proposals, statutory consultation [expected] – Ofgem are expected to launch a Statutory Consultation on Capacity Market Rule change proposals. More detail about these changes can be found on the CMAG website. Scheduled for publication in March 2026.

NESO Data Portal Update II - We are updating how Capacity Market Registers (CMRs) are published to improve accessibility and usability. Changes include report consolidation, new hosting platforms, and added data features for better analysis.

Dispute Improvements: technical improvements to allow EMR Delivery Body to run the Dispute process more efficiently.
