New Modification and Request for Urgency

CMP451: Suspending TNUoS payments when TOs and/or NESO has delayed connection date

The current TNUoS rules require a full year of TNUoS payments even if the connection is made part way through a year. Where a delay to connection date arises due to failure by the TOs and/or NESO to deliver capacity on time, it is not reasonable for a generator to be charged a full year TNUoS where capacity and energisation has been delayed.

The Panel by majority agreed that CMP451 has substantially the same effect as Pending CUSC Modification Proposal CMP445 and directed the Code Administrator to reject the Proposal under CUSC clause 8.16.6.
