



Sunny spells most prolonged for central/southern England and Wales, plus eastern Scotland, with cloud building more at times elsewhere. Blustery for Scotland, with coastal gales in the northwest. Tonight: Rain arriving into northwest Scotland initially, turning lighter as it reaches Northern Ireland and northern England by dawn. Clear skies to the south with fog patches and a widespread frost.
