### **Request for Information**

Thank you for your request for information which we received on 21 March 2025.

Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

# Request

You asked us for, in relation to the T-4 Auction results for Delivery Years 2024/25 and 2025/26, a breakdown of the awarded capacity i.e., by technology and by built status.

## **Our response**

The T-4 Reports for Delivery Years (DYs) 2024/2025 and 2025/2026 do not feature a "Capacity Procured by Technology Type" table (unlike the T-4 reports for DY 2026/2027 onwards).

We can confirm that we do not hold the information in that format.

Details on all Capacity Market Units (CMUs) participating in the relevant auction, indicating whether they secured a Capacity Agreement, their CMU Classification, De-rated Capacity, Contract Duration, and Fuel Type (i.e., the Technology Type), is provided in Appendix A of the reports.
