## **Key areas of discussion**

The Chair outlined the meeting agenda, which included a review of the query and action log, legal text review, review Terms of Reference, review Workgroup Report and hold the Workgroup vote.

## **Action and Query Log**

The Workgroup reviewed the action and query log and closed off actions which had been completed.

Consumer Impact Analysis

The Proposer presented updated slides on consumer impact analysis, incorporating additional years and specific WACC per technology, which were reviewed and accepted by the Workgroup and closed off this action.

#### **Legal Text Review**

The NESO legal SME presented updates to the legal text, including changes to the PCF activation threshold and provisions for staged projects, which were discussed and agreed upon by the Workgroup at the previous meeting. The updates involved removing unnecessary wording and clarifying the process for the PCF activation threshold, introducing provisions to ensure correct PCF calculation for staged projects, and allowing NESO to issue updated cancellation charge statements and release security held for the PCF.

#### **Terms of Reference Review**

The Workgroup reviewed the Terms of Reference to ensure all points, including EBR implications, connection timelines, and the impact on distribution-connected projects,





were covered in the work group report. The Workgroup agreed that all Terms of reference had been addressed and documented in the report.

### **Workgroup Report Review**

The Workgroup reviewed the comments received on the Workgroup Report and made the necessary changes. The Workgroup agreed the report accurately reflects the discussions and decisions made throughout the Workgroup process.

#### **WACM2 Discussion**

The Workgroup had an extensive discussion on the WACM2 proposal, focusing on the process for tech reduction and termination, including the need for a mod app, formal notification, and the implications of timing on the PCF calculation. Following further discussions, it was agreed that WACM2 would remain as intended with a 90-day notification period, and the legal text would be redrafted to reflect this, ensuring clarity and alignment with the original intent.

## **Next Steps**

• The final Workgroup meeting will be held on 30 May 2025 to agree the legal text and hold the Workgroup vote.
