

Longer spells of rain spreading across the north later. Cooler with brisk northerly winds, though feeling warm in any spells of sunshine. Tonight: Showers gradually clear to the east with clear spells developing for many western areas. A continued risk of scattered showers slipping southwards in the east. Feeling fresher for all.
