Industry Updates

EU-UK summit update by Matthew Ramsden, DESNZ

Matthew Ramsden gave a verbal EU-UK summit update and asked for industry feedback.

The Chair introduced and presented a slide on the context of the UK-EU Summit and agreed Common Understanding and current status of UK and EU electricity regulations ([please see the meeting slides for details](#)).

Matthew Ramsden gave a verbal UK-EU summit update, summarising the energy cooperation elements of the [Common Understanding](#), and asked for JESG members' views on the summit outcomes and in particular the agreement to explore the UK's possible participation in the EU's internal electricity market.

JESG discussed the practical aspects of transitioning from the Brexit-amended UK framework to the latest EU framework, noting the following:

- The need to identifying divergences and necessary technical and legislative adjustments.
- The broader impacts of EU law, including emissions legislation and environmental laws.
- Switzerland's recent agreement with the EU as a potential model for the UK.
