Grid Code Review Panel Headline Report 17 July 2025

New Modifications

The following new Modification Proposal was presented to the Panel:

GC0183: Generator and Interconnector Availability During a Severe Space Weather Event

This modification will make changes to the Grid Code to obligate Generators and Interconnectors to notify NESO of their intended position in the event of severe space weather.

The Panel unanimously agreed that GC0183 met the Authority's Urgency criteria (b) and therefore recommended urgent treatment. Panel's recommendation was sent on 17 July 2025 seeking an Authority decision by 5pm on 29 July 2025.

The Panel recommended that GC0183 should proceed to a Workgroup. The Panel did not approve the Terms of Reference for the Workgroup.
