



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Cloudy and rather humid at first with bands of rain spreading steadily northwards, heaviest in the southwest and across Scotland. Brighter by the afternoon but the risk of heavy, thundery showers remains. Fresher for many, feeling warm in the sunshine. Tonight: Rain continues to affect Scotland and Northern Ireland overnight, whilst further heavy showers spread into the south, Drier with clear spells across Wales and central England. Mild but less muggy.
