STC Panel Headline Report 30 July 2025

Approval of Panel Minutes

The meeting minutes from the Panel on 21 May were approved and these have been uploaded to our <u>website</u>.

New Modifications

The following new Modification Proposal was presented to the Panel:

CM0102 Rectification to implementation of various legal text

This proposal aims to correct the legal text errors in modifications which have been approved by the Authority (CM086, CM087, CM095, CM098, CM099)

The Panel unanimously agreed that CM0102 should follow the Fast Track Self-Governance route and proceed to the Fast Track Self-Governance Appeals window.

(Post Panel Meeting note: Following the conclusion of the July Panel meeting, Panel members identified errors in the Legal Text. This modification will not be issued to industry but will be reviewed, reworked, and presented to Panel again at the August Panel meeting.)

- Definition of Excepted Works (which is mis-spelt in STC as "expected works") and
- Definition of Attributable Works in the STC
