



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: A weakening band of rain will spread southeastwards across Scotland and Northern Ireland this morning, before moving into northern England and north Wales this afternoon. Blustery showers following behind, but largely fine and sunny ahead of it in the south. Tonight: Showers across Scotland becoming confined to coastal northern and western areas with winds also slowly easing. Mostly dry and clear elsewhere, with some pockets of fog in the south.
