

This modification is expected to have a: Low impact on Parties to the System Operator Transmission Owner Code (STC) and National Energy System Operator (NESO).



What is the issue?

Following a review of Legal Text approved by the Authority and implemented through various modifications on dates between August 2024 to June 2025, NESO highlighted Legal Text inaccuracies. This modification proposes to make minor changes to the text which will correct those inaccuracies.

Why change?

These changes should be made to the STC to correct errors that have occurred as a result of the implementation of the following modifications:

- CM086 'Introducing Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners & Transmission Service Providers'
- CM087 'Introducing Connections Process to facilitate Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners'
- CM095 'Implementing Connections Reform'
- CM098 'Updating STC Arrangements to replacing the Electricity Arbitration
 Association with the London Court of International Arbitration'
- CM099 'Removing references to "Fax" and "Facsimile" within the STC'

What is the solution?

Proposer's Solution

Changes are proposed that will correct minor typographical and formatting errors within the STC Legal Text documents, to ensure that they are accurate and align with the intended terms and facts agreed within the modifications.

The corrections include correction of the following Legal Text implementations:

- <u>CM086</u>: Sections B, D, G, and J;
- CM087: Section D;
- CM095: Sections D and J;
- CM098: Section F;
- CM099: Section B and Schedule 15
