1. Introductions, Apologies and Declarations of Interest

11122. Apologies were received from Claire Newton, David Michie, Gurpal Singh, Jamie Beardsall, John Harrower, Matthew White and Robert Longden.

2. Workgroup Reports

GC0183: Generator and Interconnector Availability During a Severe Space Weather Event

11123. CG gave a presentation on GC0183, which aims to make changes to the Grid Code to obligate Generators and Interconnectors to notify NESO of their intended position in the event of severe space weather. CG noted that the Space Weather Industry Protocol delivery date had recently been delayed and advised that the Code Administrator Consultation would be amended slightly to reflect this.

11124. CG advised that the Workgroup concluded unanimously that the Original solution better facilitated the Applicable Objectives than the Baseline.

11125. CG also advised that the Workgroup believed they had met their Terms of Reference. CG noted that a Panel member had queried prior to the meeting whether Term of Reference (f) was correct, with CG advising it was correct and that an amendment to Term of Reference (f) had been agreed at the Panel meeting on 21 August 2025.

11126. The Panel agreed that the Workgroup had met the Terms of Reference of the modification and that it can proceed to Code Administrator Consultation. The Panel asked for minor amendments to be made to the

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Code Administrator Consultation prior to publishing, to make it clear that there is no expectation on Users to prepare to implement new processes ahead of an Authority decision.
