Request for Information

Thank you for your request for information which we received on 26 August 2025. Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR) as we have determined that information relating to 'turn down' costs for windfarms falls within the definition of environmental information as set out in Regulation 2(1)(c) of the EIR.

Request

You asked us:

NESO's 2025 Annual Balancing Costs Report, published in June 2025, does not provide the component of constraint costs specifically attributable to "turn down" payments to wind farms, along with the associated volumes.

This is the information I am seeking: for each financial year covered in the above report, please provide the total "turn down" payments to wind farms, and the volume of curtailed output these payments were attributable to. Furthermore, and if possible, please also break down these payments and volumes by nation. In other words: break down the data into: England, Wales, and Scotland.

Our response

Please find enclosed 'turn down' costs for wind farms. The information provided is the bid costs and volumes for wind, for England & Wales and Scotland by financial year for 2018/19 to 2024/25 inclusive. This concludes our response to your request.
