# 1. Overview

- 1.1 Purpose
- 1.1.1 The purpose of the guidance document is to outline the specific process for Applicants to submit a copy of their Qualification Appeal notice to the Delivery Body, on the EMR Delivery Body Portal, including how to submit the actual appeal to the Authority (Ofgem).
- 1.2 Considerations
- 1.2.1 This document is accurate at the time of publishing and is based on the information provided in the final Contract Allocation Framework and published timeline for AR7 and AR7a. This guidance is to be used in conjunction with the Authority's produced guidance.
- 1.3 Scope
- 1.3.1 This guidance document is intended to be used by organisations who have been notified of a non-qualifying outcome in a non-qualification review (a "Non- Qualification Review Notice") from the Delivery Body and are seeking to ensure they understand the process for how to submit a Qualification Appeal notice.

# 3. The Authority's Guidance

- 3.1.1 The disputes process concerning non-qualification determinations, qualification appeals, is managed by the Authority.

# 4. Key stages of non-qualification appeals

- 4.1 **Stage 1** Submission of Appeal
- 4.1.1 The Applicant submits the Qualification Appeal to the Authority and then provides a copy to the Delivery Body on the EMR Delivery Body Portal. This must be done within 5 Working Days from receipt of Non-qualification Review Notice. The Delivery Body will notify stakeholders that there are appeals in progress.
- 4.2 **Stage 2** Authority Review of Appeal
- 4.2.1 The Authority must determine a Qualification Appeal as soon as practicable. The Allocation process may proceed if there is a delay in receiving an Authority decision.
- 4.3 **Stage 3** Delivery Body Information Request
- 4.3.1 The Authority may by notice require the Delivery Body to provide it with information to assist the Authority to determine a qualification appeal.
- 4.4 **Stage 4** Authority Determination
- 4.4.1 **The Authority can overturn or uphold the original decision and provide reasons for the Determination**. The Authority gives notice to the applicant and Delivery Body, stating its determination and the date of the determination. Post the outcome, the Delivery Body establishes the Appeals Register once CfD Notifications have been issued.
- 4.5 **Stage 5** High court Appeals
- 4.5.1 The Applicant has 28 calendar days to appeal to High Court or Court of Session in Scotland, where The Authority upholds the Delivery Body's decision. The High Court could then ask The Authority to reconsider their decision and/or direct the Delivery Body to reinstate the application as a Qualifying Applicant.





# 4.6 Key Dates for AR7a And AR7

Applicants notified of outcome of non-qualification review (a "Non-Qualification Review Notice")	17 October 2025
Window for non-qualifying applicants to request a Qualification Appeal (Tier 2 appeal)	20 – 24 October 2025
Non-qualifying Applicants notified of the outcome of Qualification Appeal (Determinations of the Authority)	28 November 2025*  *This is an indicative date and is subject to change

# 5. Non-Qualification Appeal Notice Requirements

**Please note that Applicants must first submit the appeal to the Authority** before providing the copy of Appeal to the Delivery Body. Information on the process of how to do this can be found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>.

# 5.1 The Appeal Notice provided to the Authority

# 5.1.1 Pursuant to Regulation 44(1), the Appeal Notice must contain:

- (a) a concise statement identifying the relevant part of the Delivery Body's decision in dispute and setting out the facts on which the appellant relies;
- (b) a summary of the grounds for disputing the Delivery Body's decision;
- (c) a succinct presentation of the arguments supporting each of the grounds for dispute;
- (d) a schedule listing the documents submitted with the request for a nonqualification review

# 5.1.2 Pursuant to Regulation 44(2), the Appeal Notice should be accompanied by copies of:

- (a) the non-qualification determination;
- (b) the non-qualification review decision notice;
- (c) any information or evidence submitted to the Delivery Body to support the nonqualification review by the Delivery Body;
- (d) any other relevant documentary evidence which the appellant wishes to rely on in support of its appeal which was provided to the Delivery Body before the non-qualification review was made;

- (e) evidence to show what evidence was before the Delivery Body when the nonqualification review was made. For example, if the applicant is seeking to demonstrate that the Delivery Body had a document in its possession related to the reviewable decision that was not considered by the Delivery Body in making that decision.
- (f) No other information or documentary evidence should be supplied with the appeal notice.

# 6. Entering the Required Information in the EMR Delivery Body Portal

- 6.1 High-level process steps for updating the EMR Delivery Body Portal
- 6.1.1 The Main Admin or Deputy Main Admin logs into the EMR Delivery Body Portal.
- 6.1.2 The user should select the "Contracts for Difference"/"Reviews and Appeals" from the menu on the left-hand side of the portal.
- 6.1.3 The user should now select "**Provide Copy of Appeal**" and then from the menu select the applicable application and select "**Create**".
- 6.1.4 Finally, the user should add the attachment (Copy of Appeal) and select "Submit".
- 6.2 Process steps with screenshots

Please be advised the screenshots below are taken from the Delivery Body's test environment so the EMR portal may be displayed slightly different on some pages for users in 2025.

In the EMR Delivery Body Portal, the main admin or deputy main admin should click on "Contracts for Difference"/"Reviews and Appeals.

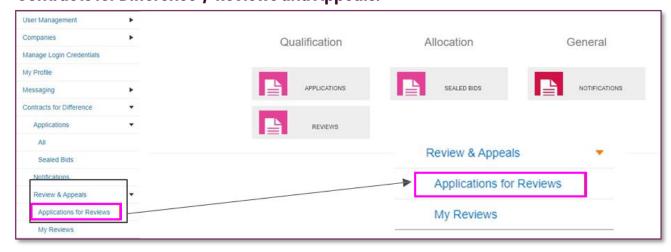


Figure 1 – EMR Delivery Body Portal homepage





- 6.2.1 The applications that have a non-qualifying after review status will now be visible for the user to submit a copy of the appeal.
- 6.2.2 The Main Admin or Deputy Main Admin should select the **"Provide Copy of Appeal"** button. When the Provide Copy of Appeal box pops up, select the choose file button and upload the copy of appeal submitted to the Authority.

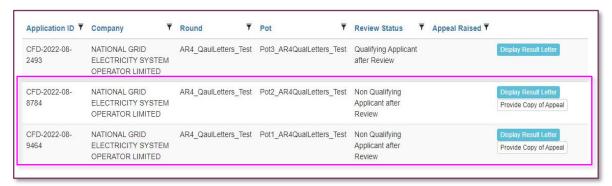
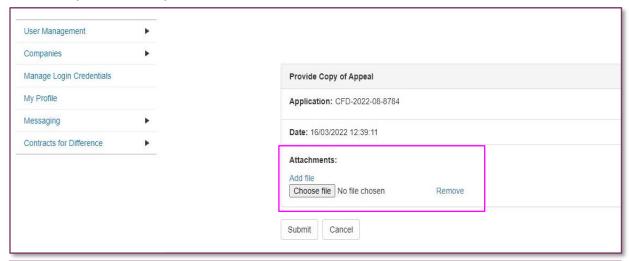


Figure 2 - Applicant view to provide copy of appeal

6.2.3 Multiple files can be uploaded at this stage, but only the documents provided to the Authority should be provided.



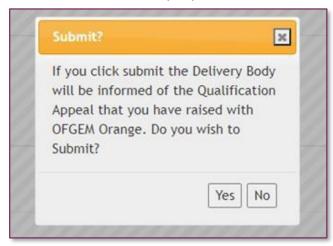
### Uploading attaches to the copy of appeal submission

- 1. Select **'Choose File'** to search for files on your computer to upload.
- 2. Select 'Add File' to add more files to the Appeal section.
- 3. Select **'Remove'** to delete files that you do not wish to include in the submission.
- 4. For **multiple file uploads**, please compile files into a single PDF or Zip Folder. The **maximum file size for uploads is 2GB**, and the mandatory file formats are Microsoft Office files, PDF or JPEG (e.g. .docx /.xlsx /.pdf).

- 6.2.4 Once the Main Admin or Deputy Main Admin has confirmed the correct attachments have been provided, select **submit**.
- 6.2.5 The EMR Portal will display a confirmation screen, select **Yes** to submit.



Applicants should not submit the copy of the Appeal Notice to the Delivery Body until this has been raised with the Authority and are con that the information provided is the same as provided to the Authority.

Applicants are unable to withdraw the copy of the Appeal Notice once the submission has been confirmed.

- 6.2.6 Once confirmed the status of the application will change to "Qualification Appeal Submitted" and the Appeal Raised column will display as "Yes".
- 6.2.7 Applicants who have provided the copy of the appeal notice will now be able to view the copy of appeal provided for their application in the EMR Delivery Body Portal.

- 6.2.8 The deadline to provide the copy of the appeal is by 5pm, 24 October 2025.
- 6.2.9 If requested by the Authority, the Delivery Body will discuss the appeals notice and comments from the application with the Authority in the Non-Qualification appeals assessment window.
