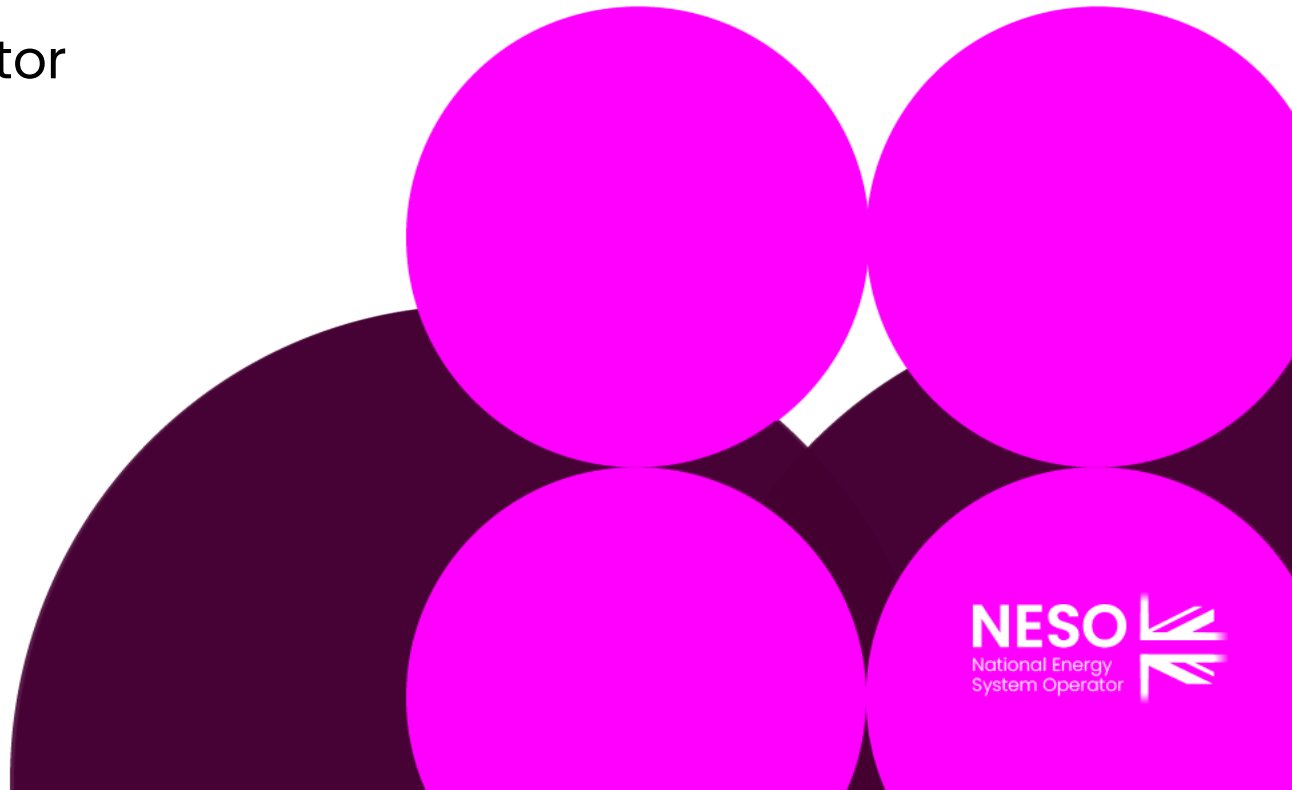

## Terms of Reference

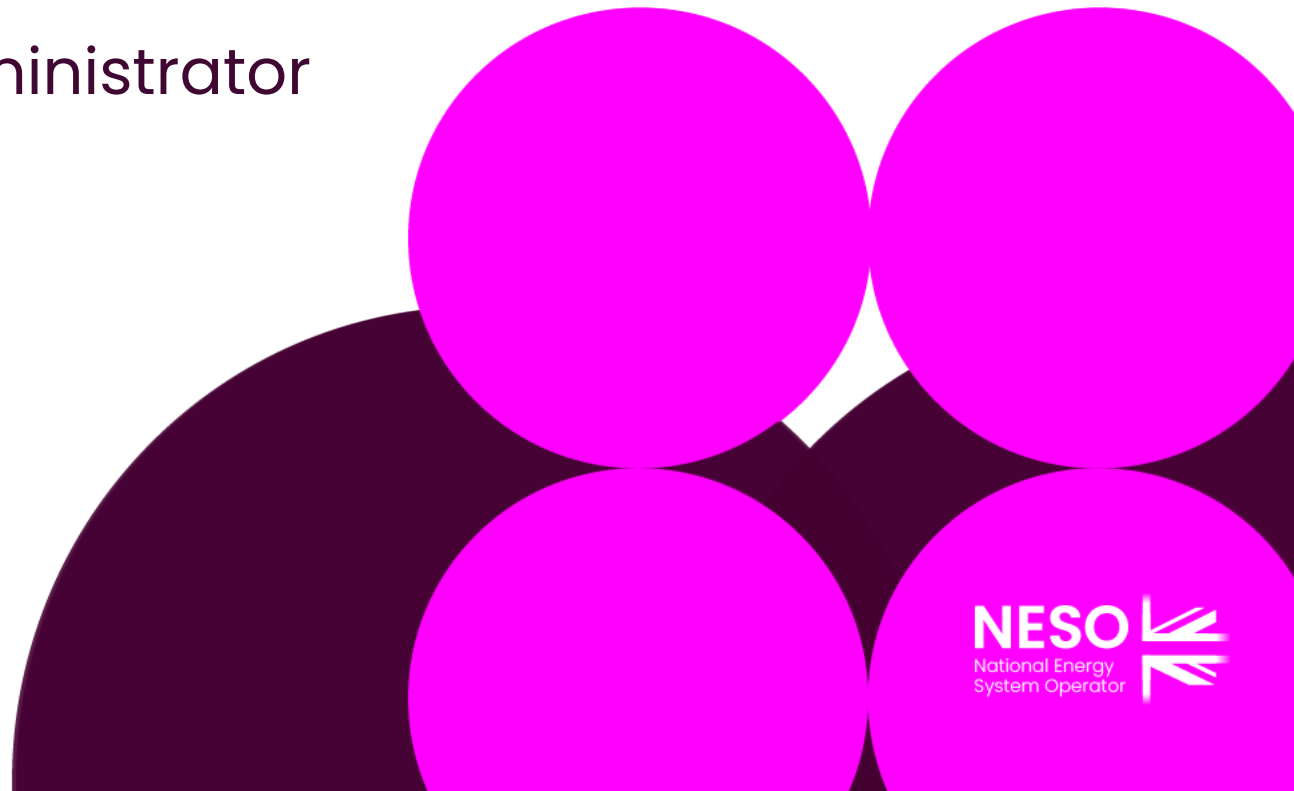
a) If there is no reliability data available, consider alternative ways of assessing the risks and the benefits for the increase of the loss of infeed risk. – relates to defect 1

b) Consider risk-based approach for the specification of any restriction on the loss of infeed risk associated with multiple cables sharing the same route.

c) Consider retrospective impact on existing cables.

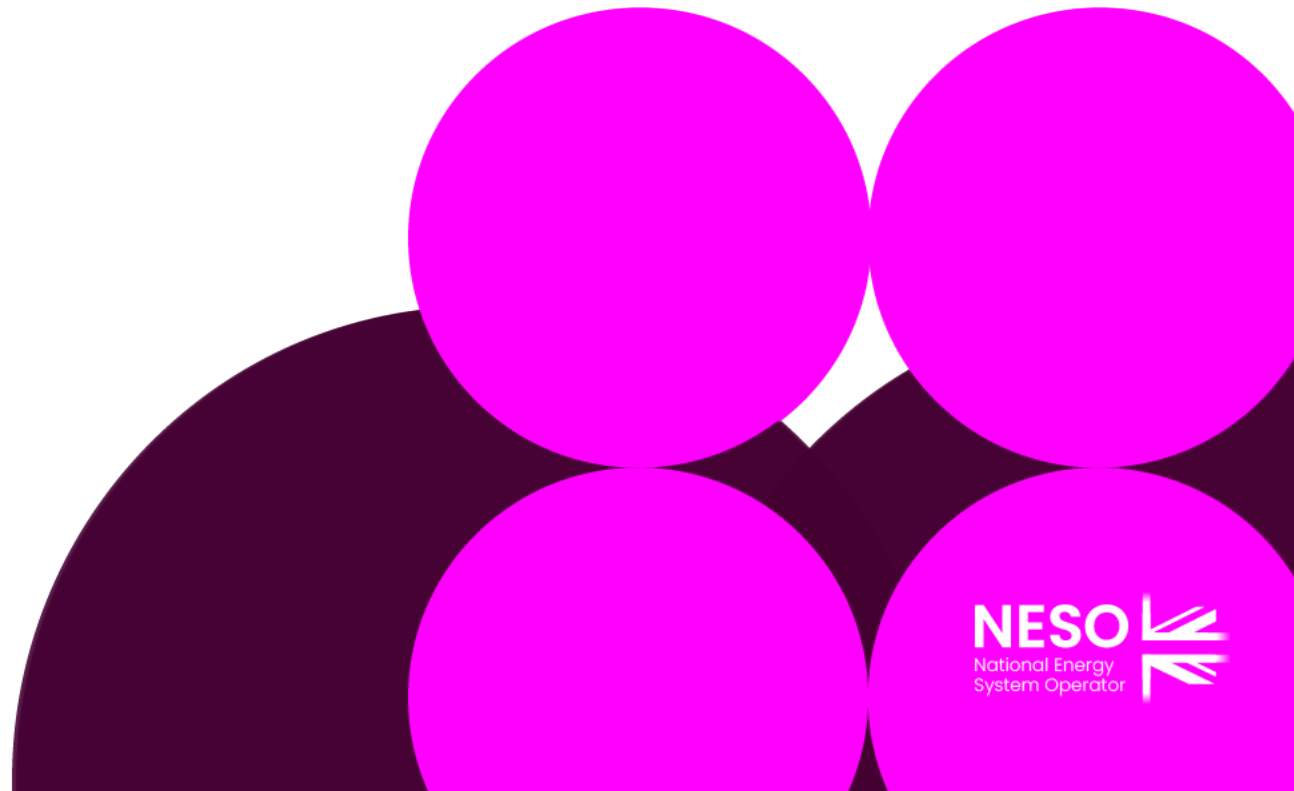

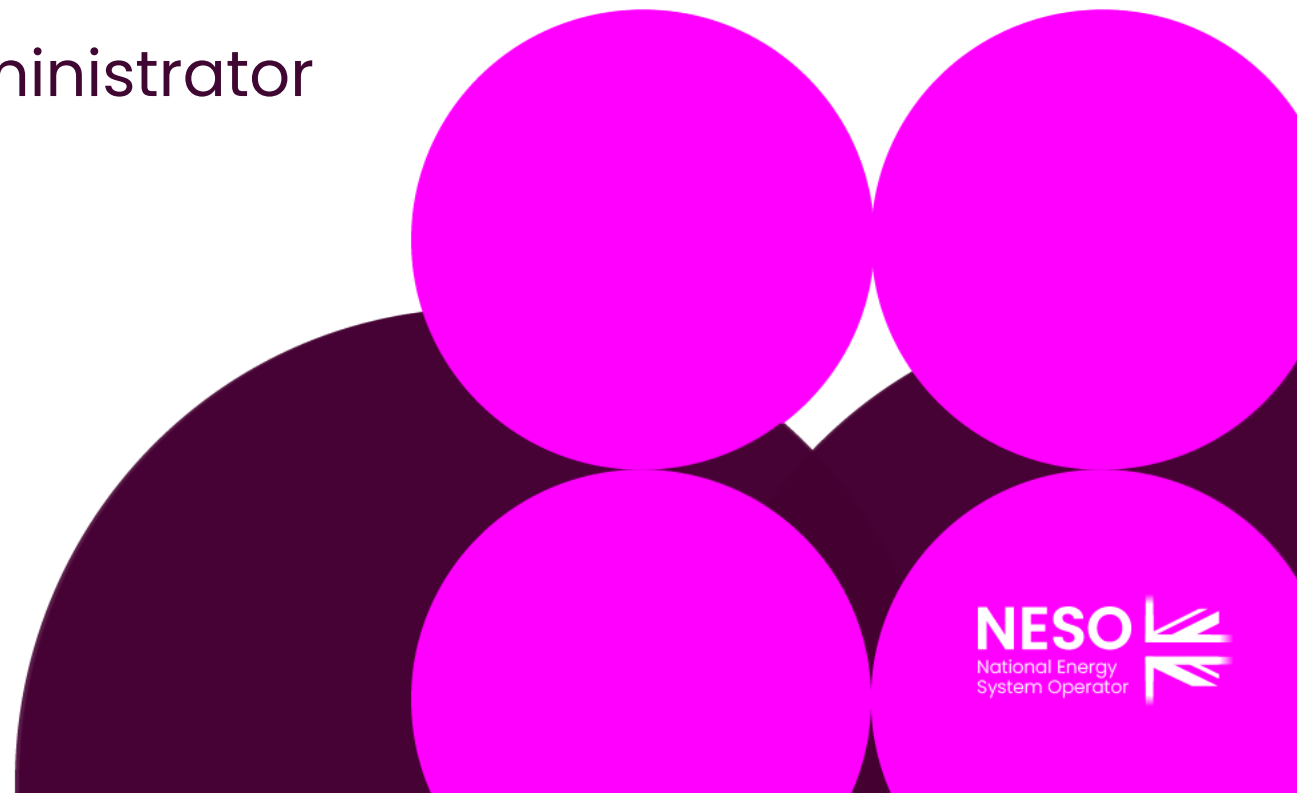
