



Latest forecast (Summary)	SEPA Natural	Today: A sunny day for most, but further sleet and snow showers for coastal stretches. Heavy across northeast England in particular, where it will remain rather windy. Cold for all, with a widespread frost reforming overnight as winds start to ease. Tonight: Showers easing in the west, some persisting in the east. Otherwise, dry with clear spells and winds easing, allowing a widespread frost to form by morning.
