1. Introductions, Apologies and Declarations of Interest

- 12971. Apologies were received from Penny Garner, Catia Gomes, Kyran Hanks and Rashmi Radhakrishnan.
- 12972. The Chair introduced Anthony Pygram to the meeting. They advised that Anthony has been appointed as the new Independent Panel Chair for both the CUSC and Grid Code Review Panel and will be in post from October 2025.
- 12973. A declaration of interest was noted by JC, who is the Proposer of CMP460.

12979. No further updates.

6. New modifications

12980. One new modification was presented to the Panel.

CMP460 'Improving Transmission Connection Asset Charging'

- 12981. JC in his role as a Proposer delivered a presentation on CMP460. JC explained that this modification proposes improvements to the framework for charging Transmission Connection Assets. The proposal seeks to socialise costs and cap customer contributions to create a more certain and fair charging methodology.
- 12982. JC advised the Panel that this modification has interactions with a DCUSA modification <u>DCP461</u>: Reducing the Impact of Transmission Distribution Charges. JC noted that although Urgency has not been requested for CMP460, to be able to progress to the proposed timeline then it would need high priority.



- 12983. The Panel held discussions regarding the solution and implementation of CMP460. It was agreed that CMP460 can be done independently but should complement the DCUSA modification. A Panel Member raised concerns about potential distortions between Transmission and Distribution, and it was noted that this would need to be considered as part of a Workgroup Terms of Reference.
- 12984. The Panel unanimously agreed that CMP460 should follow the Standard Governance route and proceed to a Workgroup. The Panel agreed the Terms of Reference for the Workgroup.

7. In flight modification updates

CMP414: CMP330/CMP374 Consequential Modification

12985. The Panel approved the new timeline as submitted within the Panel Papers.

8. Workgroup Reports

12986. Two Workgroup Reports were presented to the CUSC Panel.

CMP423: Generation Weighted Reference Node

- 12987. CG delivered a presentation on CMP423. CG explained that this modification seeks to amend the reference node to generation weighted instead of demand weighted. CG advised the Panel that the Workgroup at their final meeting, concluded by majority (7 out of 9 votes) that the Original better facilitated the Applicable Objectives than the baseline.
- 12988. The Panel agreed that the Terms of Reference have been met and agreed for CMP423 to proceed to Code Administrator Consultation. (Post meeting note: The Code Administrator Consultation was published on 09 October and will close 31 October 2025)

CMP453: To bill BSUoS on a net basis at BSC Trading Units

12989. LT advised the Panel that following May's CUSC Panel, the CUSC Panel agreed a timetable offline which allowed for this Charging Modification to be sent to Ofgem after the Section 8 Cut Off date of 30 September. An administrative error occurred, whereby the CMP453 Workgroup have been working to a different timeline. This sees the FMR being issued to Ofgem on 11 November 2025.



- 12990. A decision is required by the Authority by the end of November 2025 for NESO to make the requisite system changes to support the modification. Under CUSC 8.20.10, the Panel can amend the Terms of Reference as they see fit, and this includes the timeline as set out in 8.20.11 c). The Panel agreed to the revised timeline for CMP453. LT advised the Panel that this process error has been noted by the Code Administrator and steps will be taken to avoid a recurrence.
- 12991. LT delivered a presentation on CMP453. LT explained that the move to gross billing of Balancing Services Use of System (BSUoS) means that customers forming part of a Balancing and Settlement Code (BSC) Trading Unit are paying BSUoS when the net flows at the point of connection are exports, so the customers are not using the system and should not pay BSUoS. This modification proposes to change how the BSUoS charges are applied by billing them on a net basis for BSC Trading Units.
- 12992. The Panel agreed that the Terms of Reference have been met and agreed for CMP453 to proceed to Code Administrator Consultation. *Post meeting note: The Code Administrator Consultation was published on 29 September and closed on 20 October 2025.*

10. Discussion on Prioritisation

12994. The Panel held a monthly review of the Prioritisation Stack. The Panel discussed the prioritisation of the following Modification:
