The Panel agreed that further clarifications were needed on the proposed legal text. CMP464 will be discussed at the Panel meeting on 30 January 2026 where Panel will agree the Governance route and next steps.

<u>CMP423: Generation – weighted Reference Node</u>

The Panel has recommended by majority that the Proposer's solution better facilitates the CUSC Applicable Objectives. The Final Modification Report will be sent to Ofgem on 09 December 2025.
