Solutions / potential bids from: Subsidiary B, Subsidiary C, Subsidiary D etc.</p> <p>Will the tender submission proforma support this arrangement, allowing bidders to specify distinct contracting entities for individual solutions where these differ from the parent entity associated with the Ariba Portal account?</p>	None	<p>NESO advises that it is at the bidder's discretion how they choose to manage the relationship between a parent company and any subsidiaries when using the Ariba Portal.</p> <p>Bidders may either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Use a single Ariba account registered to a parent organisation and manage all correspondence and submissions on behalf of any relevant subsidiaries; or</li><li>- Register separate Ariba accounts for each subsidiary that intends to submit a bid.</li></ul> <p>Both approaches are acceptable.
