






Wind Power Forecast

Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	<p>Today: Cloudy for many areas with rain, especially across central and southern parts, turning heavier later. Further north, skies stay mostly cloudy, though Scotland and Northern Ireland see sunny spells and scattered showers. Staying mild for the time of year.</p> <p>Tonight: Rain clears eastwards across southern areas, leaving clearer skies. Further showers affect the far north and northwest, but much of northern UK stays dry, widespread frost, and possible icy patches.</p>
