Industry Updates

NTC Commercial Compensation methodology consultation by Joe Peffers, NESO

Joe Peffers shared details of the recently published consultation on the Commercial Compensation Methodology document relating to Net Transfer Capacity (NTC) limits NESO sets for interconnector flows. Please see the [presentation pack](#) for further details.

IEM Update by Matthew Ramsden, DESNZ

Matthew Ramsden shared an update on talks with the EU on the UK's potential participation in the EU's Internal Electricity Market. He noted the UK and EU had concluded exploratory talks and had agreed and published a Common Understanding Text in December 2025, and that the UK and EU would now move into formal negotiations. JESG discussed how industry should engage on potential implementation of any successful negotiation, and what shape and format this engagement should take. Members suggested an initial discussion of what EU rules have and have not been retained, and what has changed including through recent Code Modifications.
