

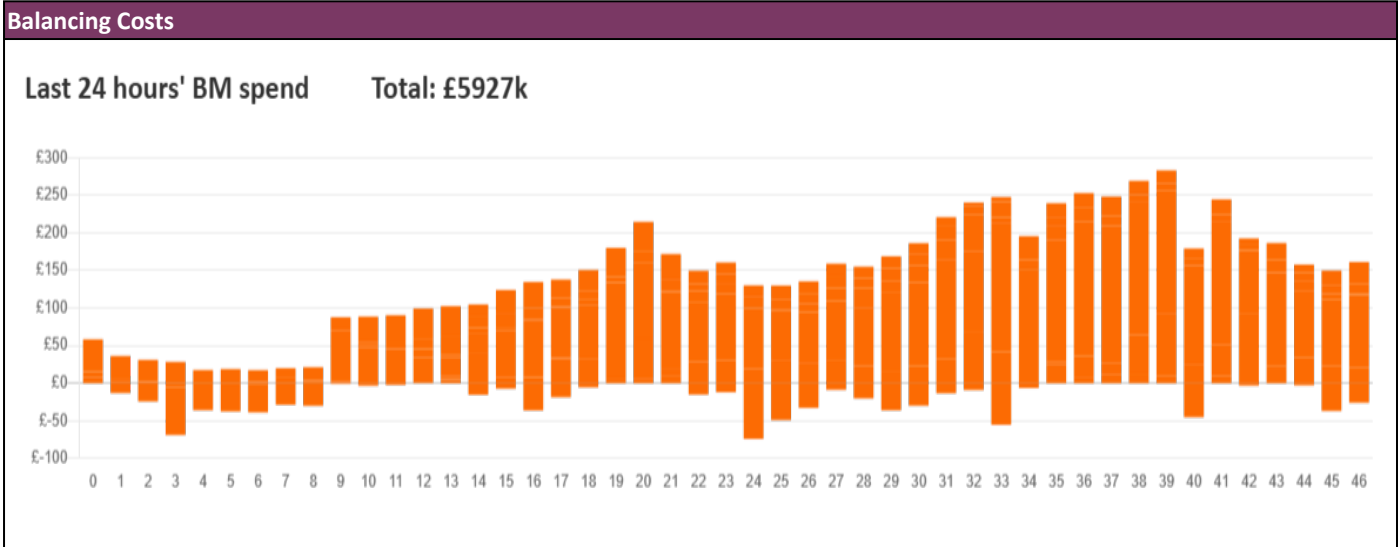

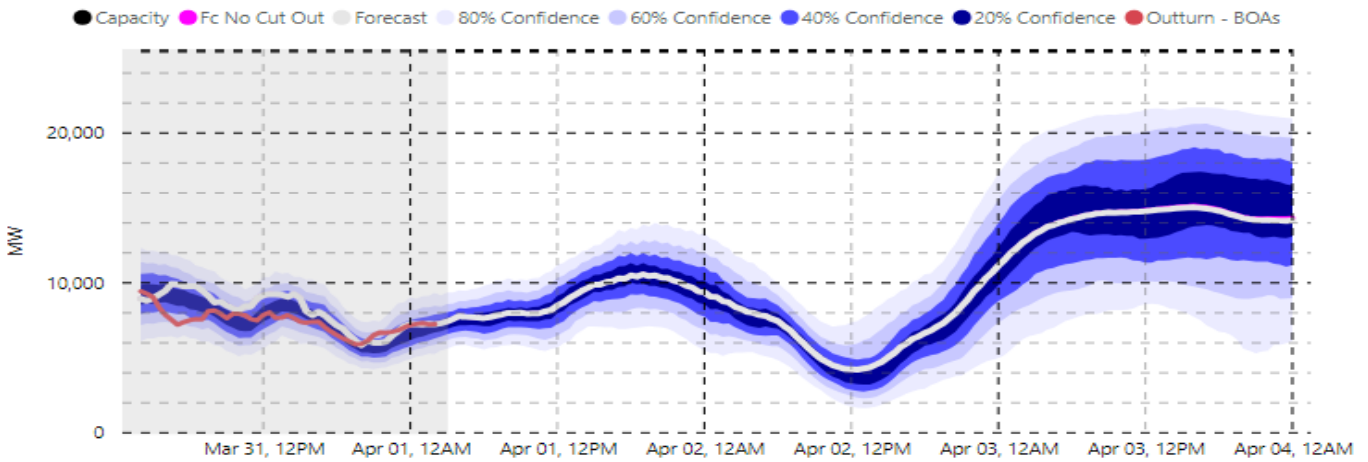

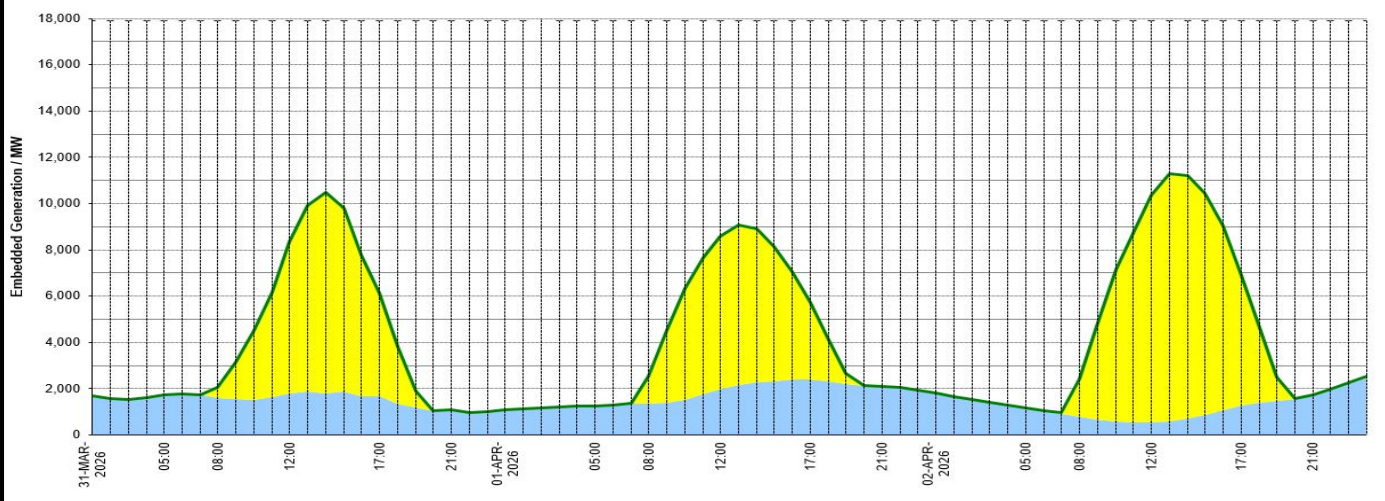
Wind Power Forecast

Ahead of this, any early fog clearing but a cloudier day overall than Tuesday. Tonight: The band of rain will continue moving southeastwards, but gradually petering out. Dry with clear spells either side of this with a widespread frost developing across the north.
