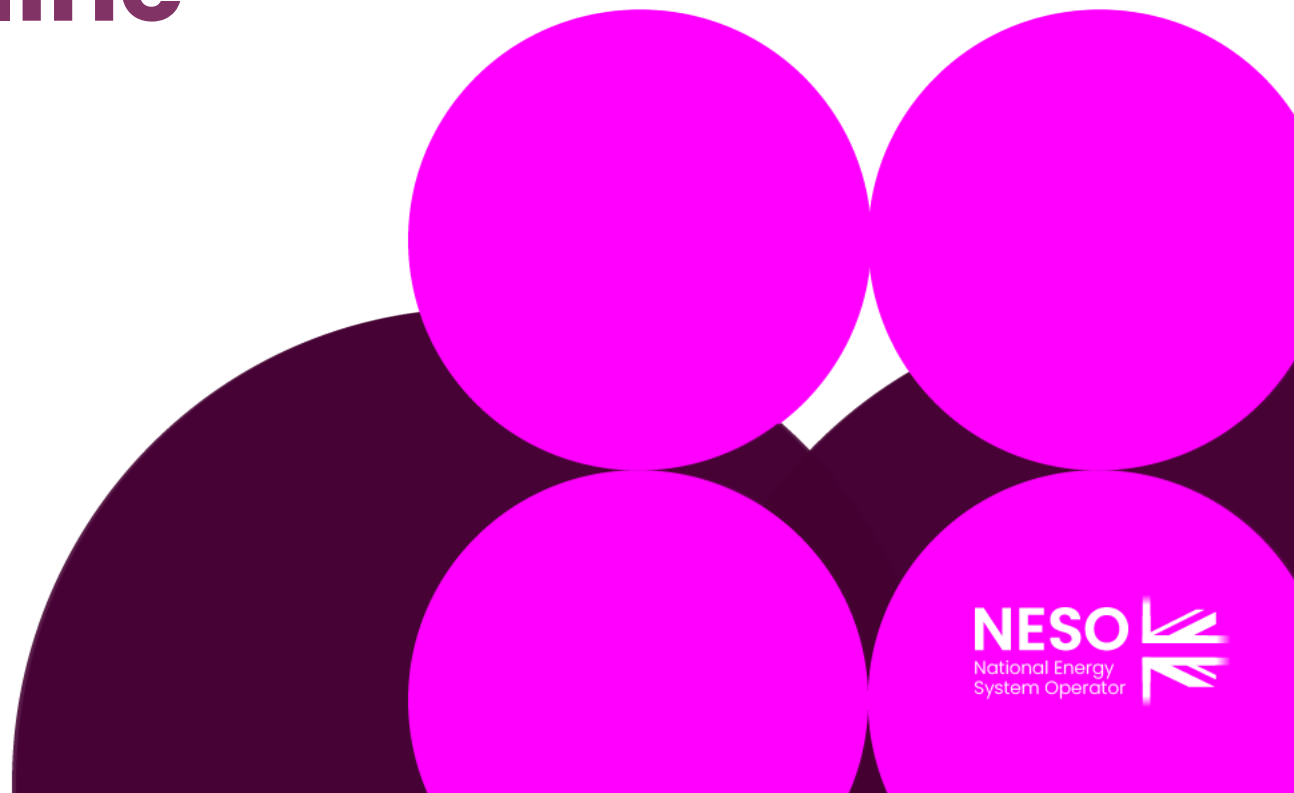

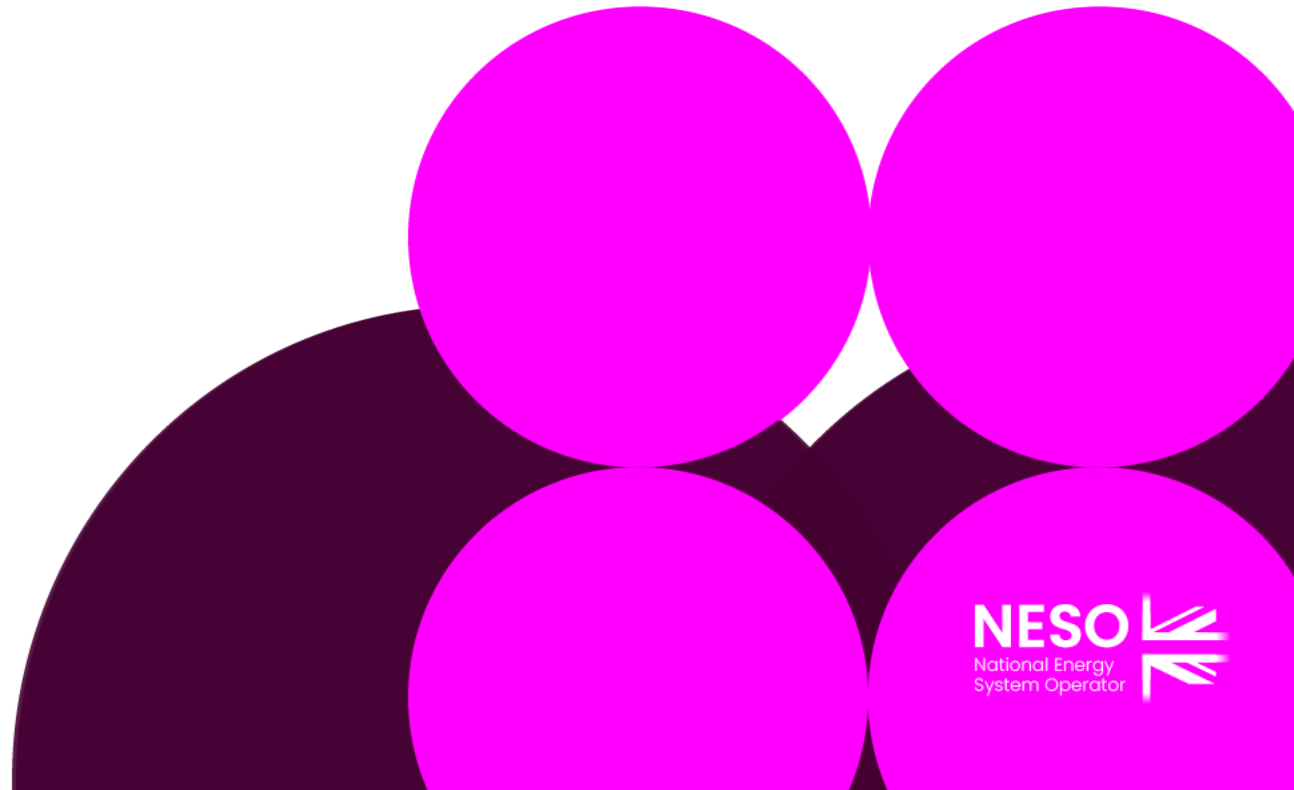

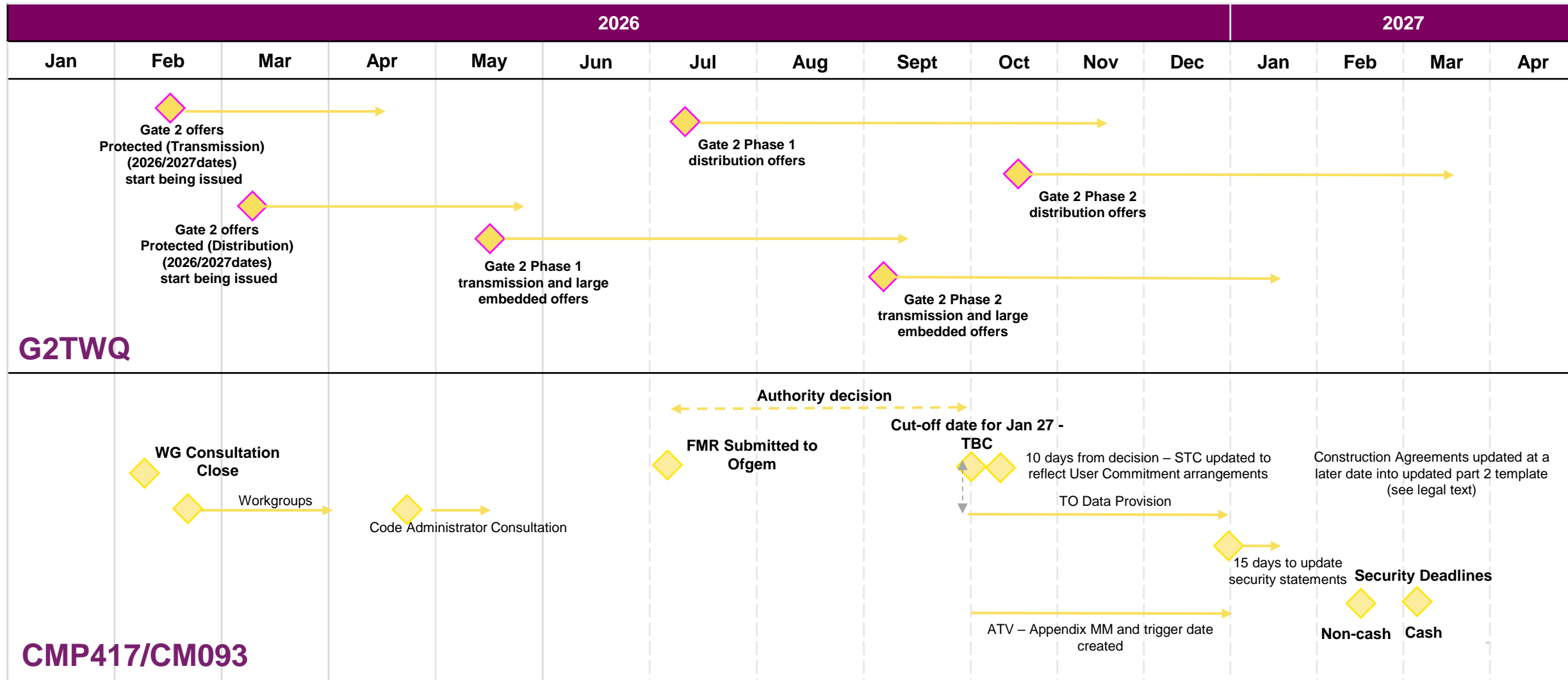


# Proposer's Update

- CM093 continues to progress in lockstep with CMP417, aligned with scope, solution, and implementation approach
- Draft legal text has been refined following Workgroup feedback, ensuring consistency across relevant STC provisions
- The implementation timeline has been clarified: implementation occurs 10 Business Days post-Authority decision
- The 82 day TO data provision requirement applies post- implementation, with no expectation of revised data ahead of approval
- Workgroup Report updates reflect the agreed implementation narrative and confirmed TO lead-in requirements

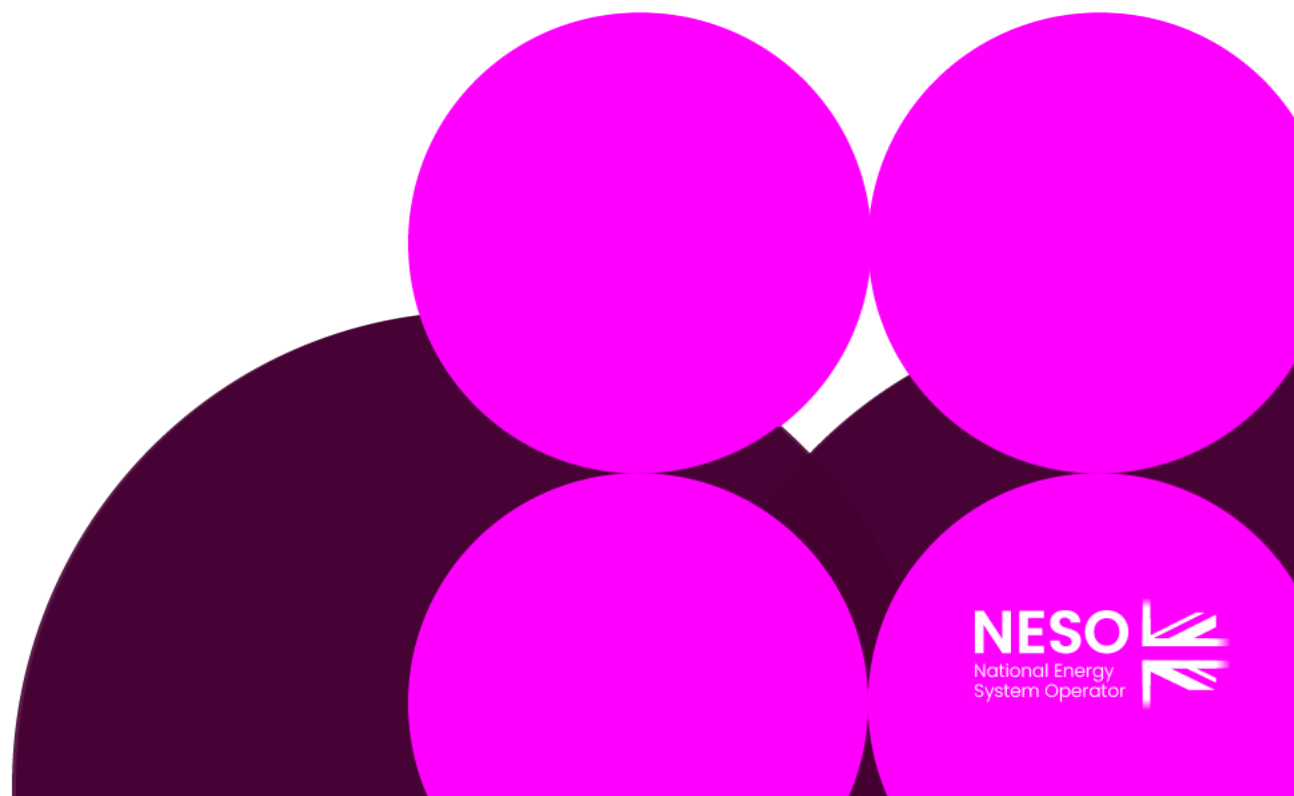
# Public CMP417/CM093 Timeline and G2TWQ Interaction

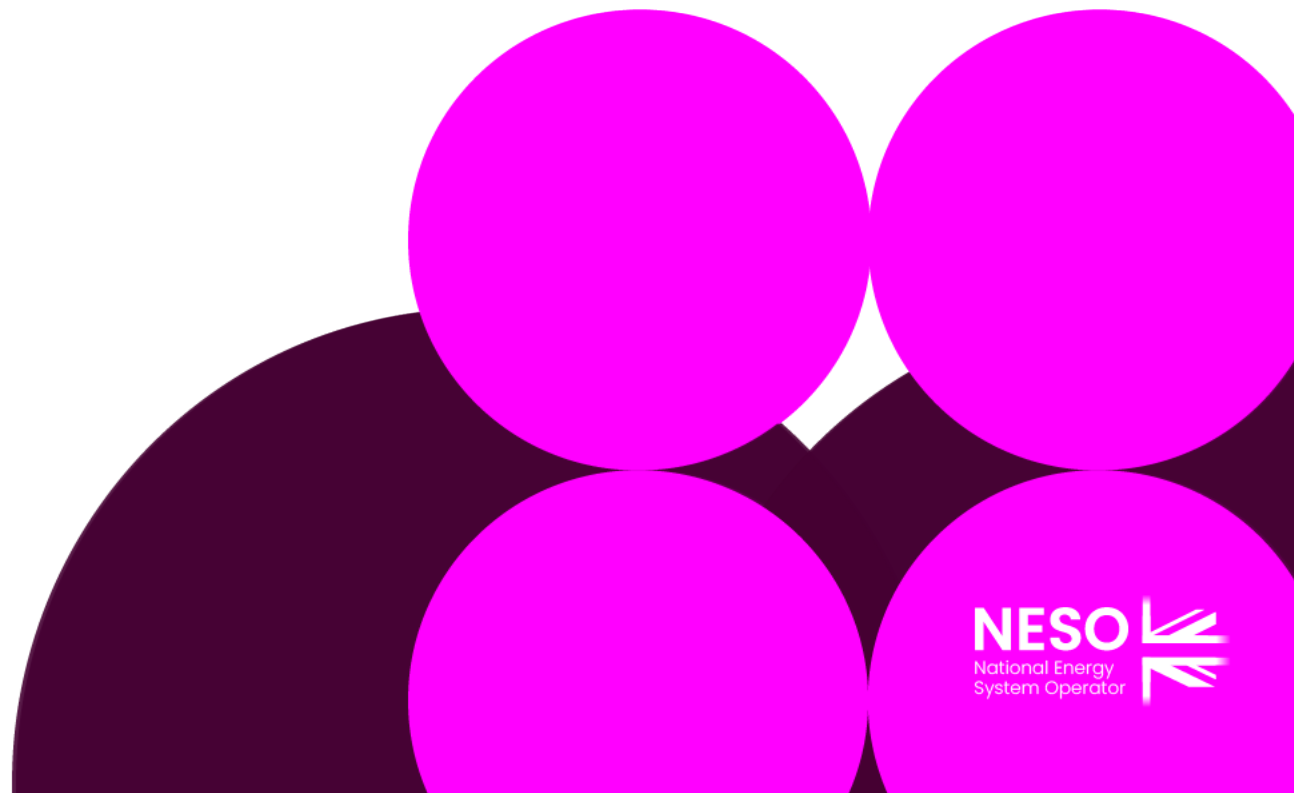


# CMP417 Workgroup 16

- Finalised Legal text shared

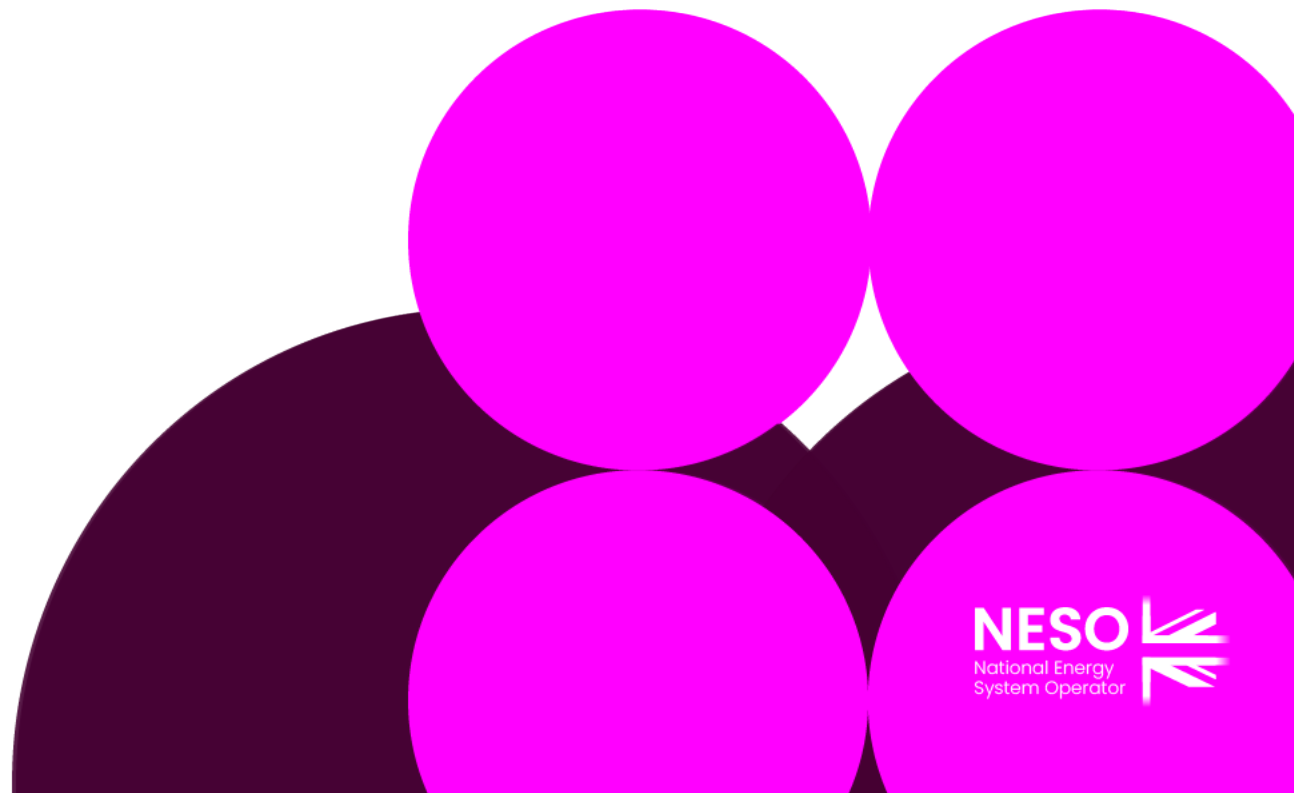

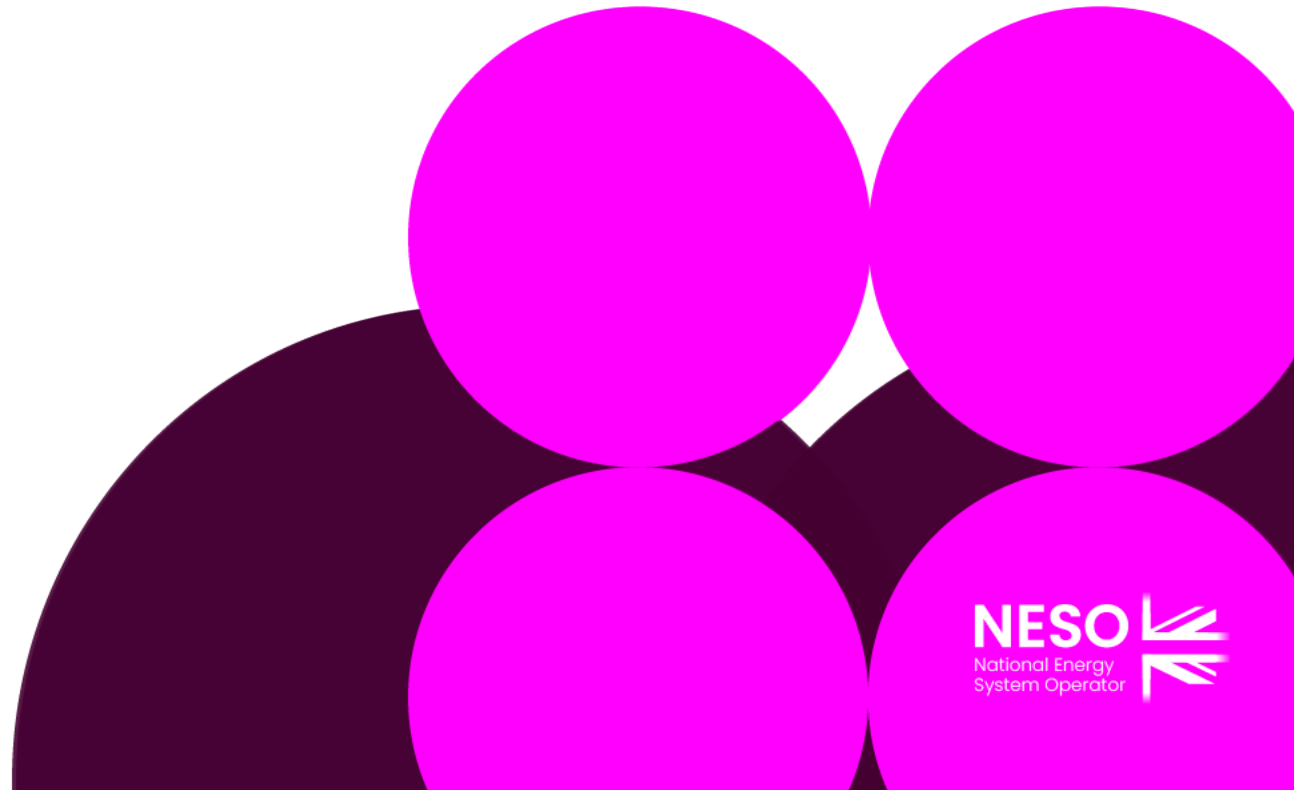

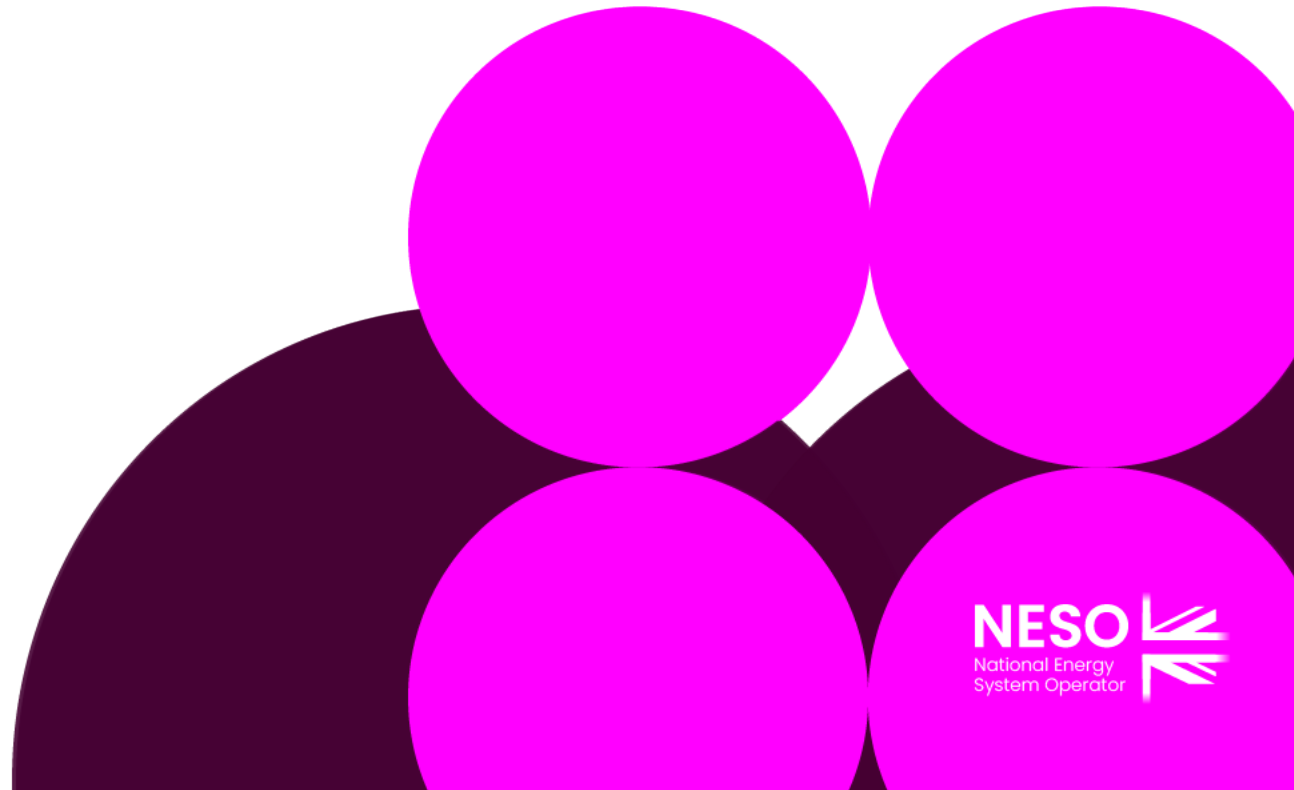
