

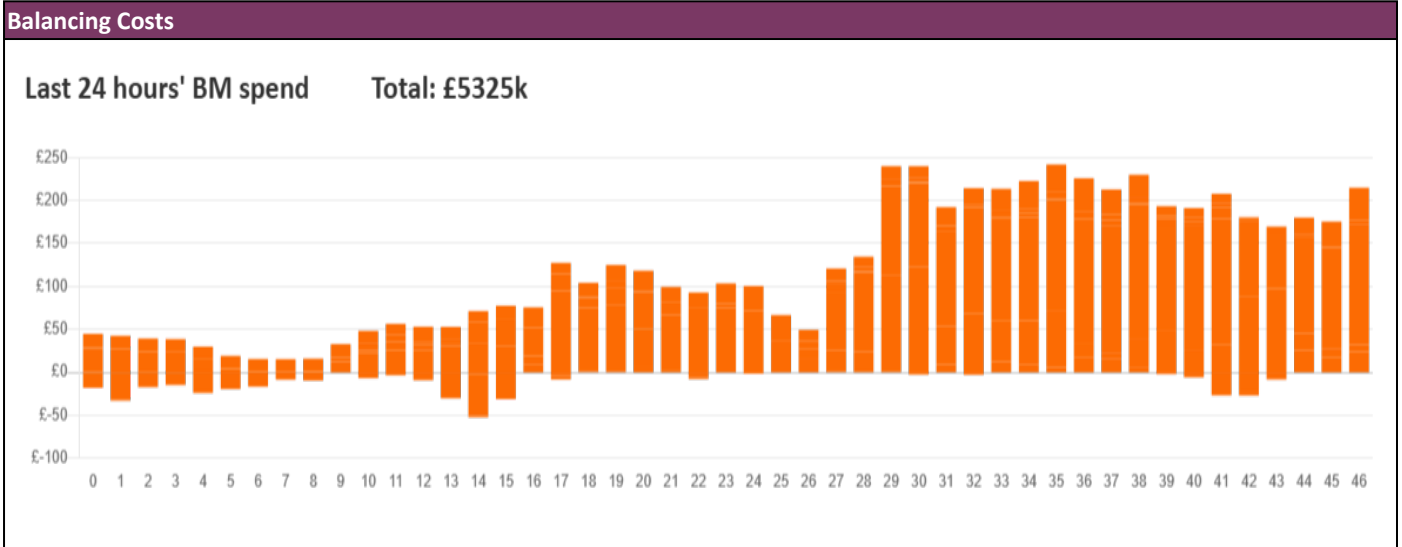

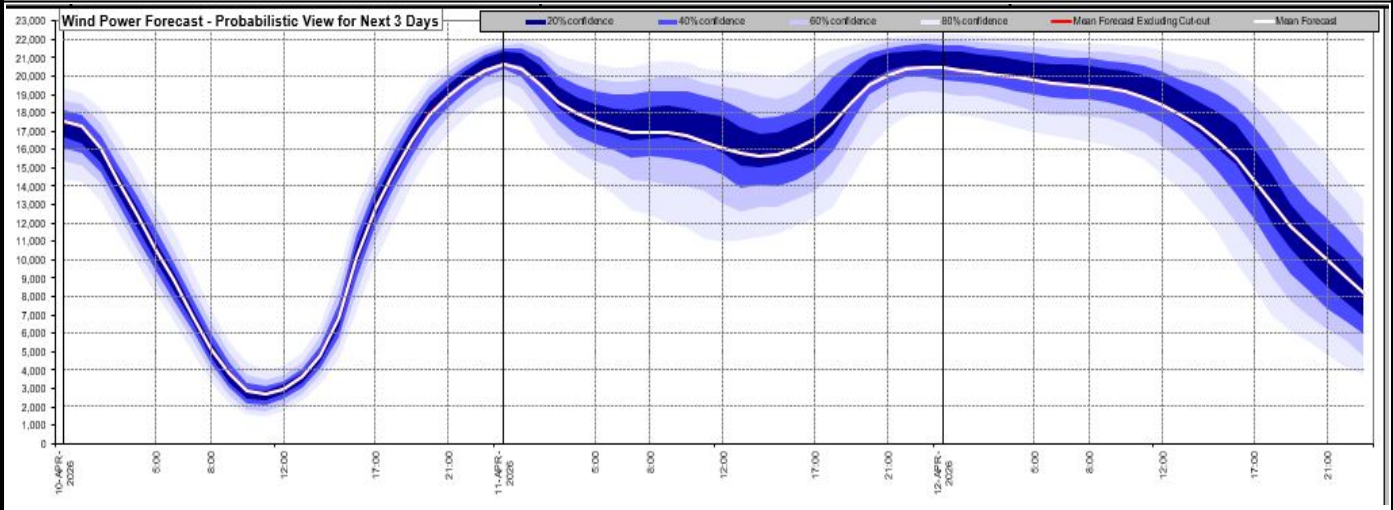

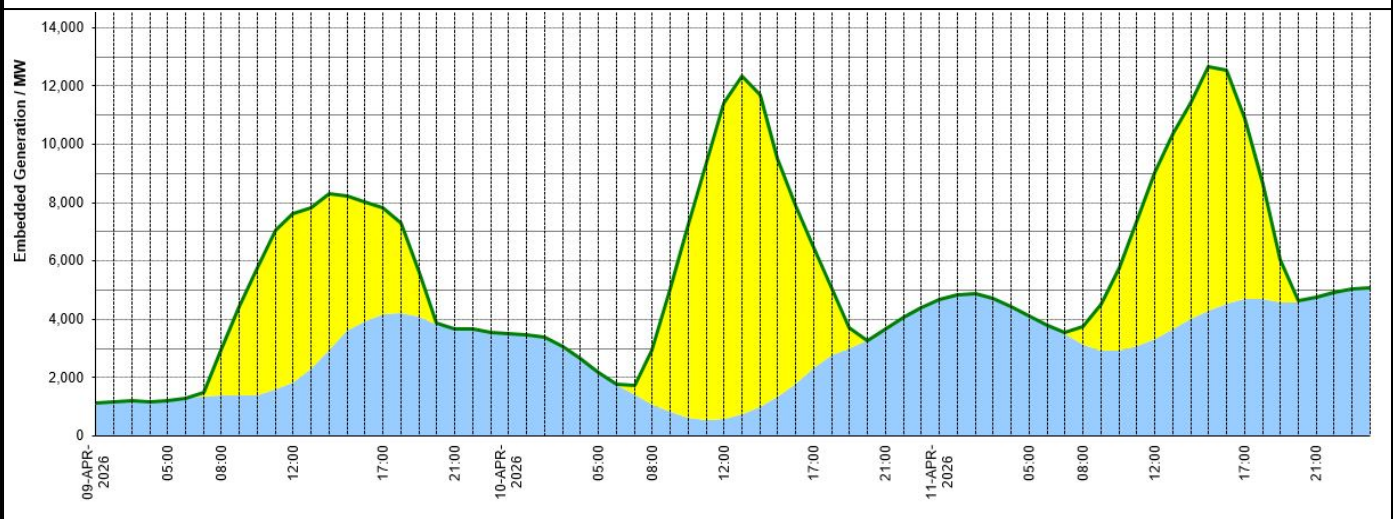
Wind Power Forecast

Cloud will increase, with rain spreading into western areas later, bringing strengthening winds and coastal gales, severe in the far northwest. Temperatures near average, colder northwest overall conditions.</p> <p>Tonight: Rain in the west, locally heavy at first, edging eastwards. Clear spells and blustery showers follow in the west, turning chilly with local rural frost as winds ease in places.</p>
