

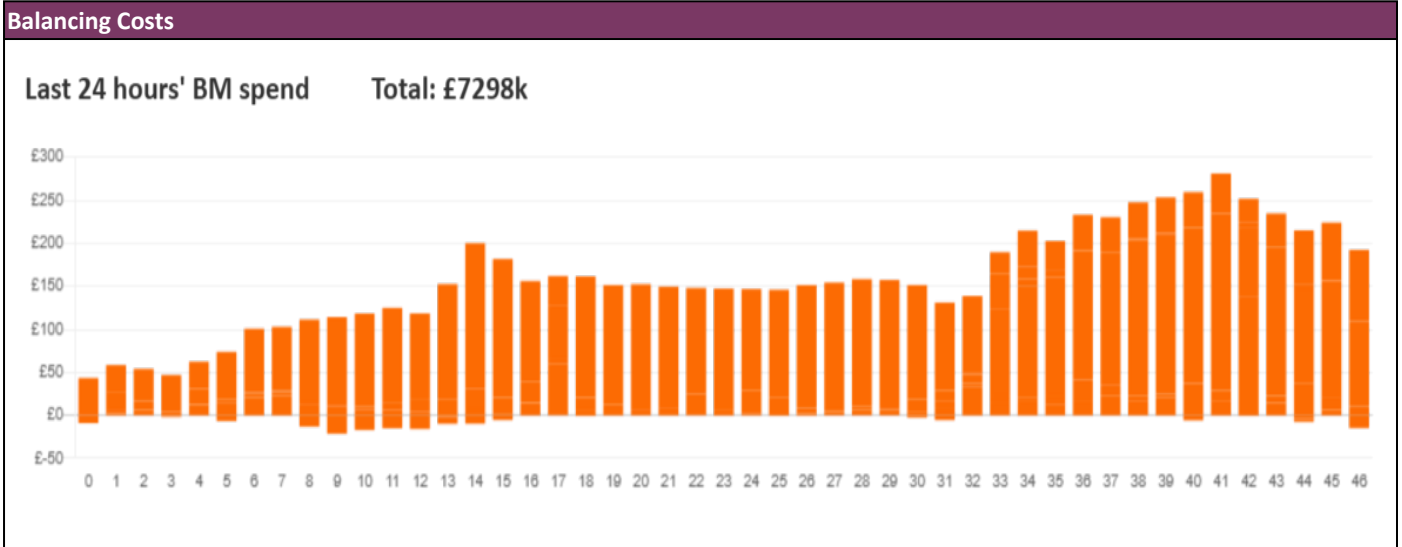

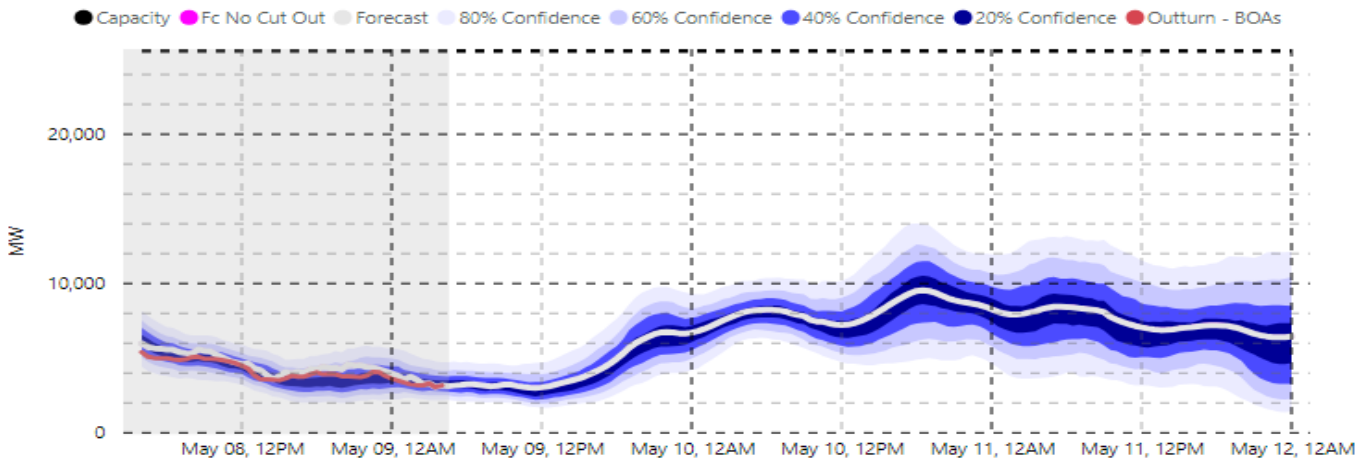

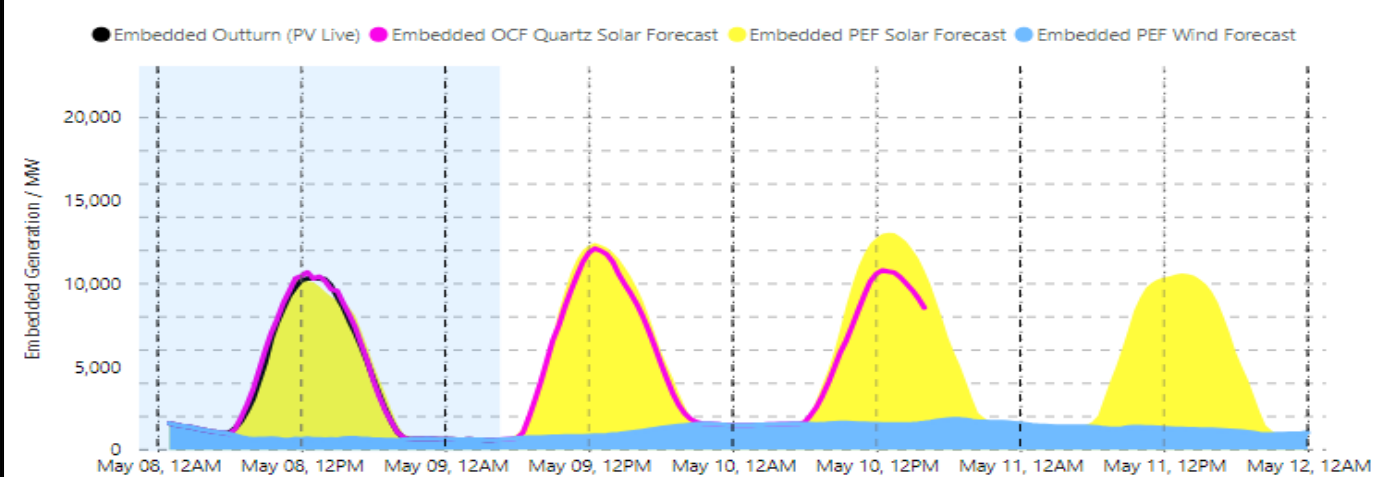
Wind Power Forecast

Elsewhere, dry with clear spells and lighter winds, allowing a rural frost to form in places.</p>
