### **Draft Final Modification Reports**

The following Draft Final Modification Report was presented to the Panel:

[GC0176: Introduction of Demand Control Rotation Protocol within Operating Code 6 of the Grid Code](#)

The modification will make changes to OC6 to allow for the Demand Control Rotation Protocol (DCRP) to be formally recognised as a tool to manage shortfalls in electricity supply for short term use.

The Panel has recommended unanimously that the Proposer’s solution better facilitates the Grid Code Applicable Objectives. The Final Modification Report will be sent to Ofgem on 01 June 2026.
