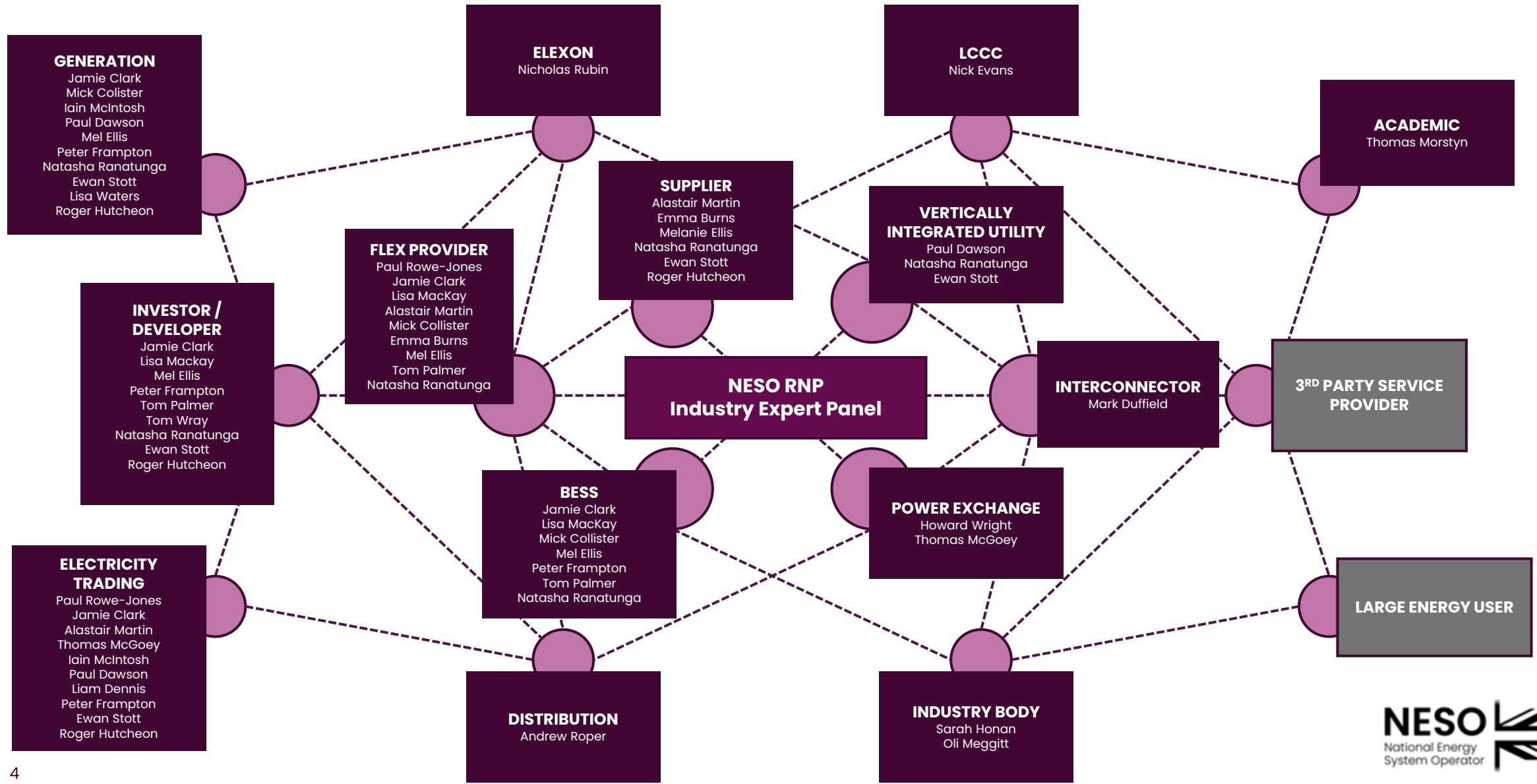

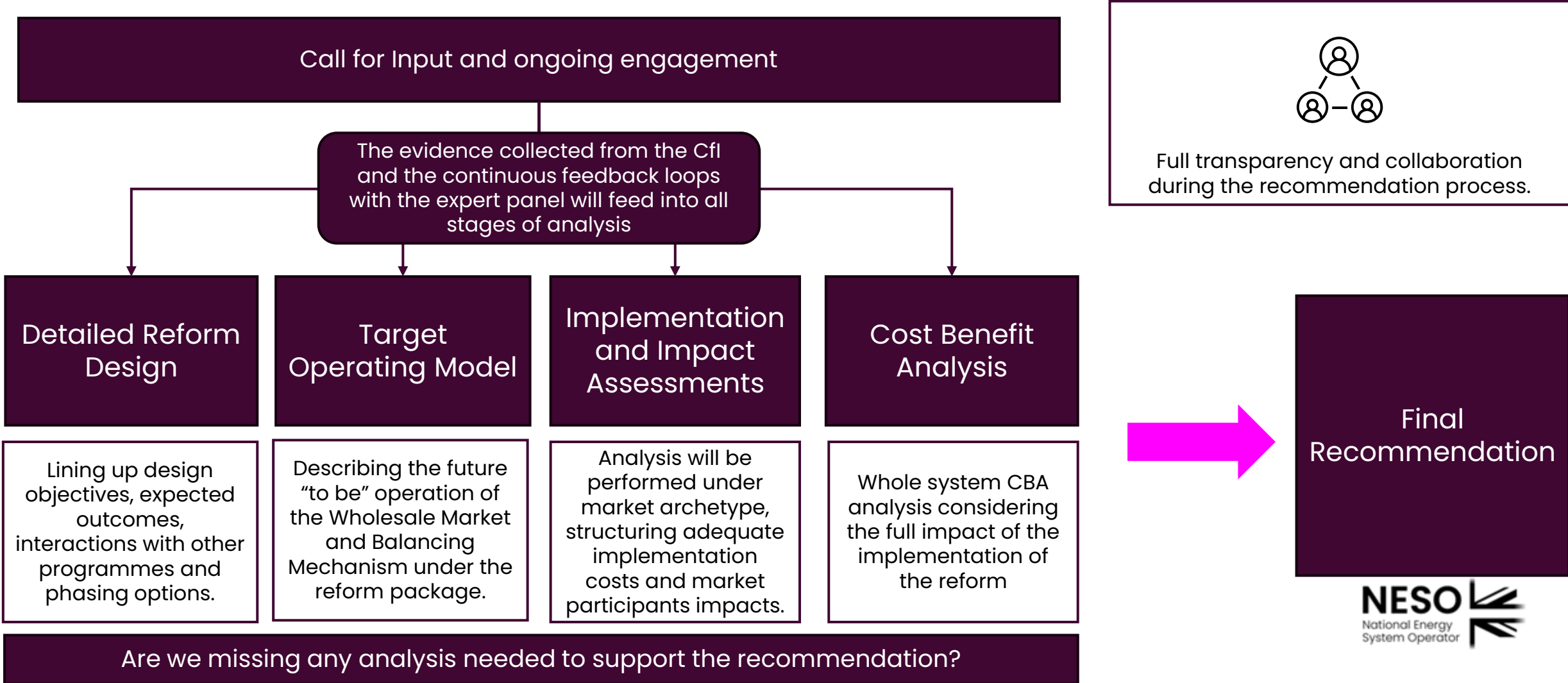

Heading	Summary	
Purpose	<p>The IEP will...:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• provide expert insight, evidence and challenge to NESO on the design of the RNP balancing, settlement &amp; dispatch reforms</li> <li>• not debate whether the reforms are the right answer, but rather support how the reforms should be designed and implemented, and cost-benefit assessed</li> <li>• not be a decision-making forum</li> <li>• not be a substitute for formal consultation</li> </ul>	
Scope	<p>Input into (more information on slide 9 – 11)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Detailed Market Design</li> <li>• Cost-benefit analysis</li> <li>• Implementation roadmap</li> <li>• Impact assessments</li> </ul>	<p>Identifying</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Risks</li> <li>• Evidence gaps</li> <li>• Practical delivery challenges</li> </ul>
Frequency of Meetings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As required in the project plan, anticipated to be roughly monthly but may be more than one in any given month</li> </ul>
