

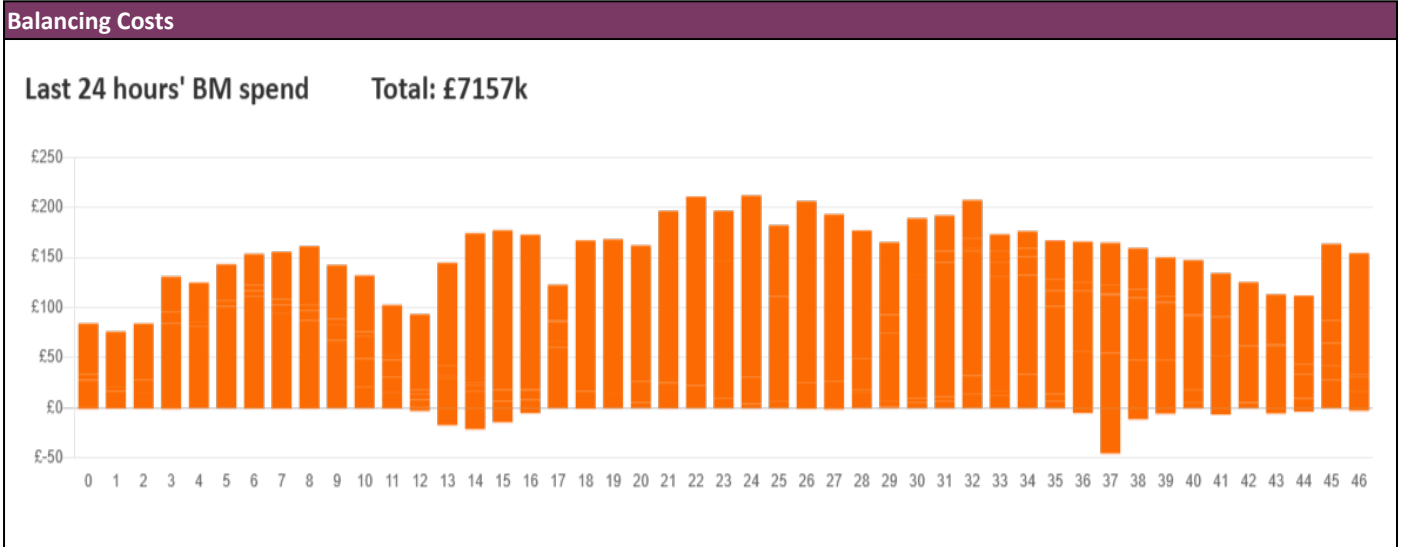

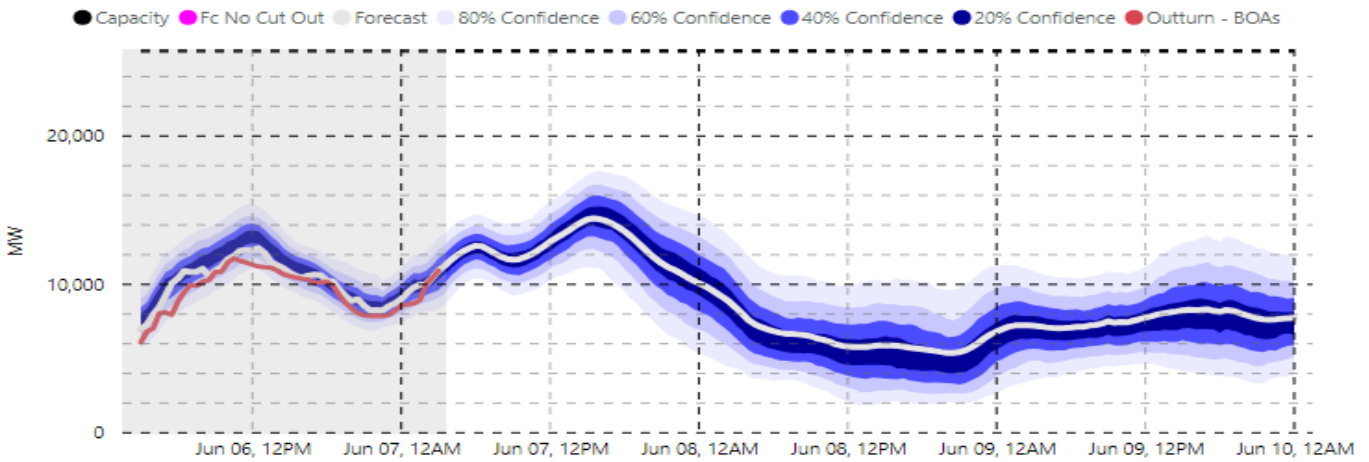

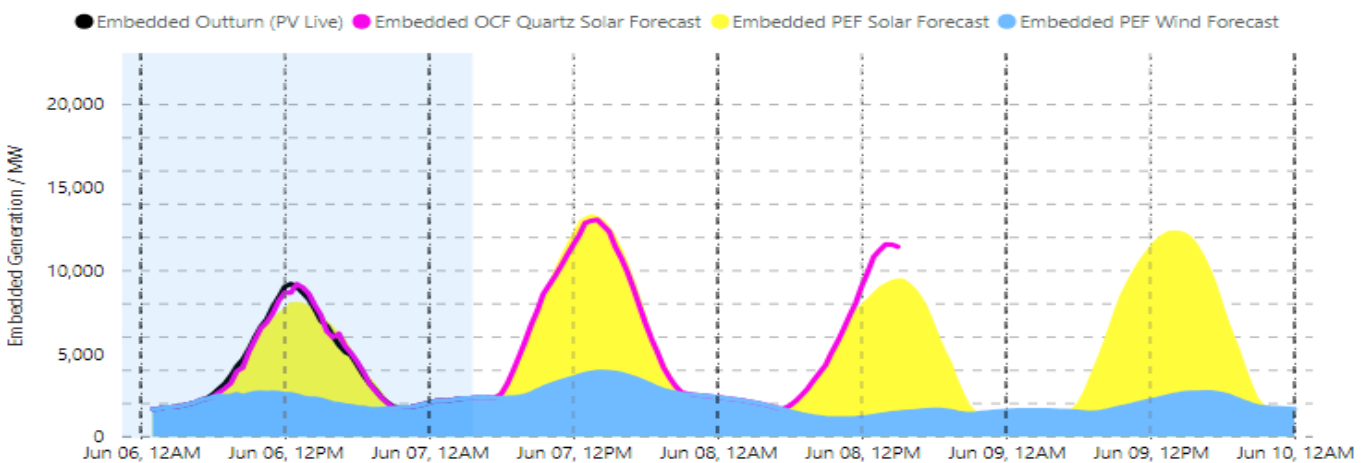
Wind Power Forecast
