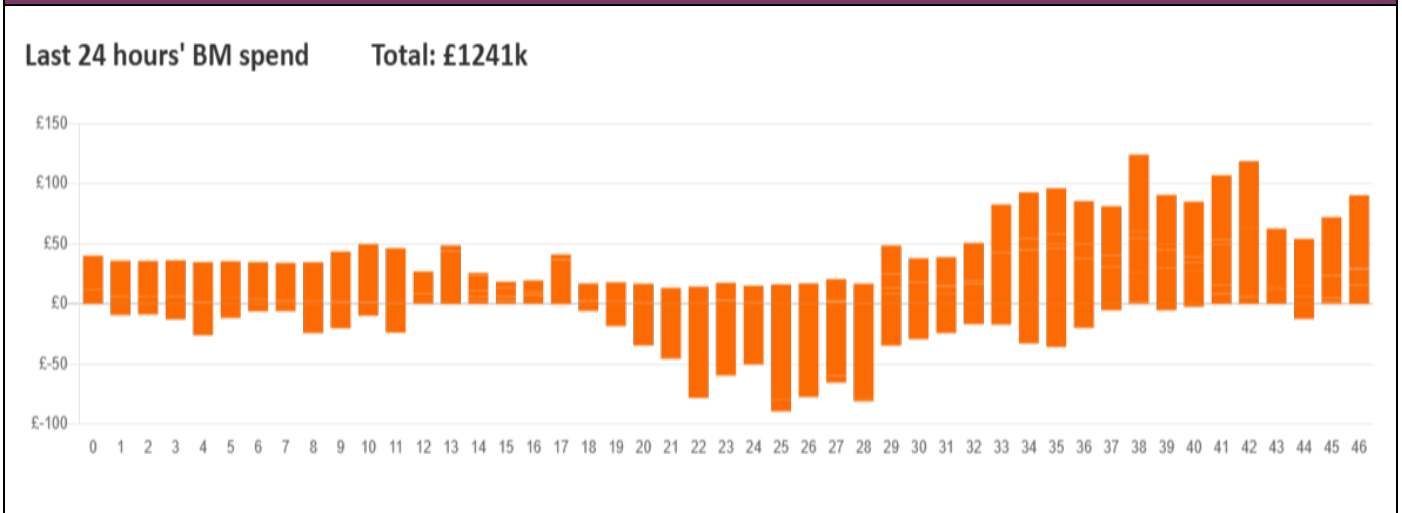

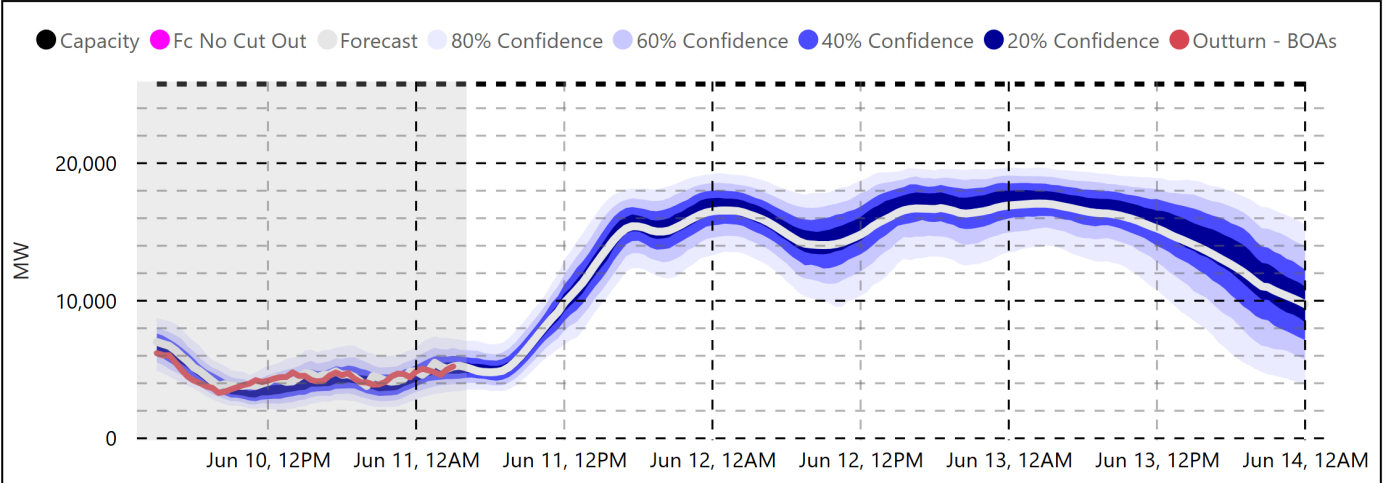

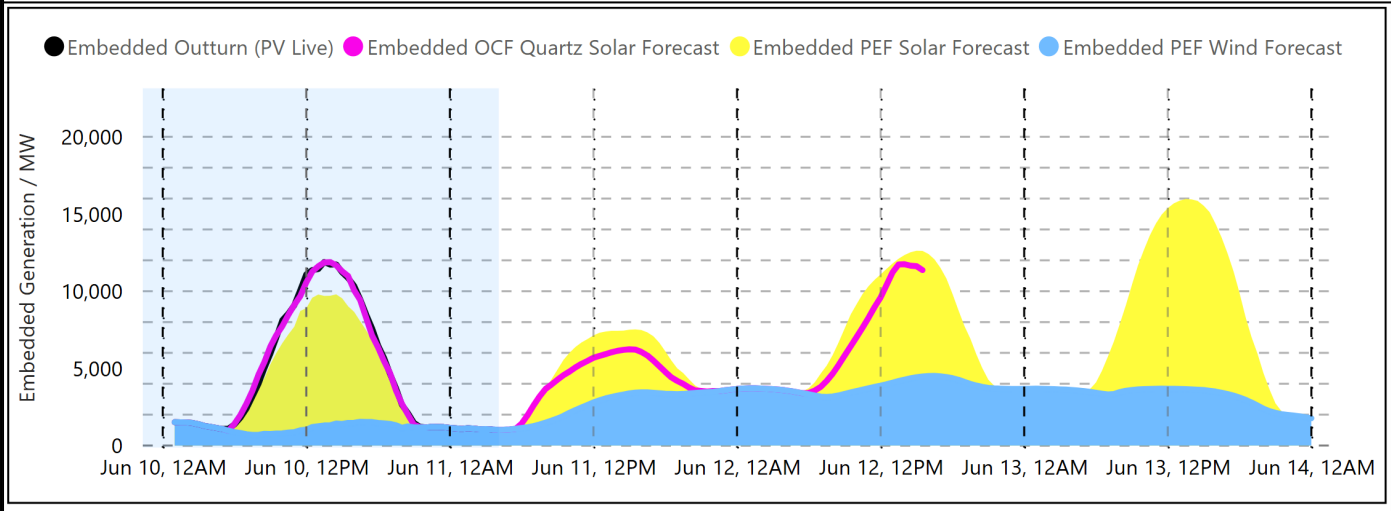
Wind Power Forecast

Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: A wet and rather windy day as rain spreads steadily east. The rain turning heavy at times, but easing later from the west. Feeling muggy under widespread cloud cover, with patchy coastal and hill fog, mainly in the west. Tonight: Outbreaks of rain becoming increasingly showery into the evening, however heavy bursts are still possible. Drier later in the night with some clear spells developing. Remaining rather windy for many.
