Industry Updates

Net Transfer Capacity Consultation – Responses & outcomes by Elana Byrne, NESO

Elana Byrne shared a deep dive into the responses and outcomes on the Commercial Compensation Methodology consultation. Please see the [presentation pack](#) for further details.

In response following on from a question in JESG about the timeline for the NTC derogation review once NESO submitted to Ofgem. Ofgem confirmed that there is no statutory timeline set out for this decision. However, Ofgem aim to have a decision before the end of September. The length of the review depends on the timing and quality of NESO's submission. Ofgem anticipate that it will take at least 2 months to review.

UK-EU IEM Agreement: Introductory session by Aislinn Dooley and Ashley Wilson, DESNZ

Aislinn Dooley and Ashley Wilson led JESG through an introductory session on UK-EU IEM Agreement.

Which focused on the following outcomes:

- Build a shared baseline understanding of what IEM participation could mean in practice
- Test initial assumptions on business readiness across industry, system and regulators
- Identify likely dependencies and early pressure points
- Surface where further technical detail is needed
- Shape the priorities and format of future workshops
