IEM engagement: Update and discussion by Rosie Carpenter, Aislinn Dooley and Ashley Wilson, DESNZ

Rosie Carpenter, Aislinn Dooley and Ashley Wilson led JESG through an update and discussion on UK-EU IEM Agreement.

Which focused on the following outcomes:

- Share a common understanding of the agreed principles underpinning a potential UK-EU Electricity Agreement.
- Provide a high-level overview of the regulations and arrangements that support the Internal Electricity Market.
- Begin identifying the potential implications for industry should participation be agreed.
- Understand where stakeholders anticipate challenges, dependencies and longer lead times.
- Gather views on the information and engagement needed to support future business readiness activities.
