

Static Firm Frequency Response and Dynamic Response Consultation updates

Ofgem has issued their decision on the Static Firm Frequency Response (Static FFR) and Dynamic Response Services Consultations. Details on each of the services' decisions and go live timescales can be found below:

Static FFR

All changes have been approved by Ofgem and will go live from auction date 30th July for delivery date of 31st July 2026. Find the updated documents below:

We are continuing to review how we can improve this service, although we do not expect to consult on significant changes in the near future, we will be looking to engage with industry to better understand provider impacts.

Dynamic Response

Ofgem has approved a number of the Dynamic Response changes to go live on delivery date the 31st July 2026. These changes include: BMU FPN flag set to FALSE will result in unavailability, Stacking Methodology reference updated, Updates to Schedule 3 and the housekeeping changes. Ofgem have also approved background submission data, faulty use of disarming flag check and ability to publish provider default data. These changes are planned to go live early 2027, we will engage with industry with additional information before these changes go live.

Although Ofgem supported the policy intent behind the Tiered Performance Regime and Unit Suspension submissions they have asked NESO to reconsult to allow industry to review the additional guidance document that has been produced to answer a number of queries raised during the consultation. We expect to reconsult on both of these submissions at the next available opportunity, which is currently expected to launch in Autumn 2026.
