Statement on interpretation of TO license obligations on offer dates:

According to the TO license conditions, NGET is obliged to provide detailed provisions within our offer as to:

Condition D4A: Obligations in relation to offers for connection etc

(d) the date by which any works required on the licensee's transmission system to facilitate access to the national electricity transmission system (including for this purpose any works on the licensee's transmission system to reinforce or extend the licensee's transmission system) shall be completed (time being of the essence unless otherwise agreed by the ISOP);

This condition ties the date provided in our offer as directly linked to the works undertaken to facilitate a connection to our network.

Under Connections Reform, and in line with the requirements of the above license and under CNDM, NGET has worked to assess the works of each individual customer through the study process. This includes assessing whether the customer has requested acceleration to a particular year through their evidence submission and whether they have indicated a willingness to be connected on a non-firm basis or to move POC to support this acceleration. This has accompanied a robust process to assess power system requirements, design detail and deliverability constraints which drives the final completion date submitted in a customer offer, in line with the license requirements outlined above.

As shared in our previous customer webinar in May, NGET has been conducting pre offer engagement with customers. As part of this engagement, our Relationship Management teams have been working with customers to understand if they require any flexibility in their connection dates.

Accommodation of these requests is subject to the full study and offer development process- and the final offer content will ultimately be subject to the results of the reassessment of our works.
