STC Panel Headline Report 26 August 2026

Approval of Panel Minutes

The meeting minutes from the Panel on 27 July 2026 were approved subject to minor comments from the Panel being incorporated and these have been uploaded to our website [here](#).

New Modifications

The following new Modification Proposal was presented to the Panel:

PM0158: Changes to TNUoS timings Protocols.

Following the Authorities request to make the final decision on PM0158, the Panel provided their recommendation vote.

Whilst Panel members broadly supported the purpose of the modification in improving TNUoS forecasting and transparency, the majority (4 of 5 voting Panel Representatives) considered that further engagement with Transmission Owners was required, particularly regarding the scope, frequency and resource implications of additional forecasting requirements.

The modification will progress to the Authority for final decision, noting that implementation will be 10 working days post approval.

<u>CM078: Connections Triggering Distribution Impact Assessment</u>	07 June 2022	TBC subject to CMP328 send back. CM078 is a consequential modification, and as a result it is not progressing independently at present.
<u>CM093: Extending the principles of the User Commitment Methodology to Final Sums Methodology as a consequence of CUSC Modification – CMP417</u>	16 July 2026	No decision has been made the modification is currently awaiting review by the Ofgem team responsible for making the determination.
<u>CM097: Electromagnetic Transient (EMT) and Root Mean Square (RMS) Model Submission for Transmission Owners (TOs)</u>	16 July 2026	No decision made. This modification is being considered by the Ofgem engineering team.
<u>PM0147: PM0147 RMS and EMT Model Sharing Process (STCP 12-2 Issue 01) National Energy System Operator</u>	16 July 2026	No decision made. Ofgem confirmed that PM0147 is linked to CM097 and GC0168. The Authority's engineering team wishes to review the Final Modification Report (FMR) for GC0168 before deciding.
<u>PM0158: Changes to TNUoS timings Protocols National Energy System Operator</u>	N/A – Awaiting materiality confirmation	No decision. Ofgem will await the statements from Panel members prior to forming their decision.
<u>PM0159: Managing STCP impacts from CMP471</u>	N/A	No decision. Further workgroup activity is required on CMP471.

Inflight Modification Updates/Potential New Modifications

CM079: Consideration of STC/STCP changes in relation to CMP330/374

The Proposer withdrew their support for CM079 on 23 July 2026. A withdrawal window was opened for 5 Business Days from this date. No parties came forward to becoming the Proposer for this modification.

The Panel agreed to the withdrawal of the modification under STC Section B, 7.2.2.6.
