Request for Information

Thank you for your request for information which we received on 8 June 2026. Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR) as the requested information meets the definition of environmental information at Regulation 2(1)(c) of the EIR.

Request

You asked us:

NESO's forecast for the net aggregate revenues/payments from generation Transmission Network Use of System Offshore Local tariffs in Financial Year 2030/31, broken down into the following two categories:

- (1.) *Generation assets located in Scottish waters*

£220.79m

- (2.) *Generation assets located in English and Welsh waters*

£945.81m

Our response

We can confirm that we hold information in scope of your request and we have annotated your request above with responses in green. Please note that the numbers for the 2030/31 financial year are part of our long-term forecast of Transmission Network Use of System tariffs, and as such are subject to change. Transmission Network Use of System tariffs only become fixed when they are published in January or at the point of asset transfer, if later, ahead of being charged for that same year from April. No assumptions have been made regarding the impact of Offshore Transmission Owner projects that are due to reach the end of the licence period during this timeframe.

Transmission Network Use of System charges allow Transmission Owners to recover their costs of constructing, operating and maintaining the transmission system both onshore and offshore in Great Britain. NESO has an administrative role in relation to these - forecasting the tariffs before collecting the charges from customers and passing them directly to the Transmission Owners.

This concludes our response to your request.
