# Special CUSC Panel Headline Report

## 19 June 2026

### **New Modifications**

The following new Modification Proposal was presented to the Panel:

#### **CMP478: 'Clarifying Protection Clause 2a'**

This proposal requires NESO to issue Gate 2 offers to 2a protected projects that are to be connected in 2026 or 2027.

The Panel by majority, did not agree that the scope and defect of the modification was clear. The Panel redirected the modification back to the Proposer to review and amend the scope and re-submit for discussion at a future CUSC Panel meeting.

### **Workgroup Reports**

The following Workgroup Reports were presented to the Panel:

#### **CMP470: 'Introducing an Oversubscribed Technologies Commitment Fee'**

This modification seeks to introduce a floor on securities through an Oversubscribed Technologies Commitment Fee for all technologies which are oversubscribed relative to Clean Power 2030 capacity targets.

The Panel agreed that the Terms of Reference have been met and agreed for CMP470 to proceed to Code Administrator Consultation. The Code Administrator Consultation will be published on 23 June 2026, and this will close on 30 June 2026.

**CMP474: ‘Fixed BSUoS Price Revision Mechanism’**

This modification seeks to introduce an inclusion in the Connection and Use of System Code (CUSC) of a clear process for when the Balancing Services Use of System (BSUoS) will be reset by the National Energy System Operator (NESO).

The Panel agreed that the Terms of Reference have been met and agreed for CMP474 to proceed to Code Administrator Consultation. The Code Administrator Consultation will be published on 23 June 2026, and this will close on 29 June 2026.

**CMP475: ‘Amendment to the BSUoS tariff reset process’**

This modification allows the National Energy System Operator (NESO) to reforecast the Fixed tariff periods and if needed recover the financial position of the Working Capital Fund, when market conditions require it.

The Panel agreed that the Terms of Reference have been met and agreed for CMP475 to proceed to Code Administrator Consultation. The Code Administrator Consultation will be published on 23 June 2026, and this will close on 29 June 2026.
